Introduction

Recently my partner seemed out of sorts - a little disturbed. As you spend more time together you notice when each other is slightly off normal - not quite on an even keel - a little distracted - starting to notice things and concentrating on something. We can see that there is something going on in their heads.

We can see this with strangers as well - they don't seem natural - maybe a little too focused on something (like your wallet and your purse). We can "sense" things are not quite "right".

Too much of this can lead to being hypersensitive, paranoia, excessive pandering and not enough means you relationship will probably fail - something in the middle then - a balanced awareness, noticing.

We all have our ups and downs.

I asked her if there was something wrong. While the immediate answer was "nothing" - a little more prodding enabled the issue to come out and a back and forth dialogue occurred. To an outsider it might look like an argument - indeed some of most fruitful discussions have been shut down by the observers - not the participants - because they were becoming worried that it was not a discussion.

This shutting down of a raised level of anxiety, exploration and even fear of being wrong or looking silly seems to be unproductive and dangerous when carried to extremes. The ability to have a good rant and explore complex and maybe personal issues seems like a good idea.

I would suggest it is probably an idea of "the west" when done well (especially ancient Romans and Greeks) and the tendency to shut down heated debate is seen more often in Totalitarian and Authoritarian societies. Big or important issues are not explored enough. Voices are silenced and censored.

Something Drives Me

I have the niggles - I have niggling concerns. Something is going on. I am aware. I Notice. Is it chaos? Things seem a little askew, a little awry ((Latin/French/English) spatially askance). I have the wobbles. I notice the beginning screech of the chaotic feedback in microphones and speakers. Something is bubbling up to the surface. Things seem out of kilter. I feel out of sorts. There is a chaotic knocking in the engine of life - things seem out of tune, disharmony grows.

Things seem out of sequence, upside down and back to front. The cart is before the horse.


How do I start? Where do I begin? Is it all too much?



task sufficiently to address my niggles. I will feel some level of satisfaction if I can do that. (but not too smug). But I need to multitask in some sense. I need to be able to notice the gorilla walking by in the room and be able to raise my awareness to address that - while still being able to focus on the task at hand. But because we operate in a linear fashion - there is no such thing as focused multitasking really (except for autonomous functions - breathing, walking, etc) - I must be able to interrupt and halt my focused task and look at the gorilla as it walks by. I must choose whether to change focus or resume my task.

But it still depends on being able to notice the gorilla in the room. In his case, he was constantly fed messages and questions he had to deal with - we was not aware of the elephant or gorillas in the room - he was busy dealing with the overwhelming amount of information he was already receiving. A thing with these kind of tools is that it can become a bit binary. That is why I don't like being too certain least the dimwit binarys (feminists, communists, fascists, religious zealots, women (on average wages, quotas) and weak minded sentient pet tame virtue signaling men) make it some kind of new dogma. It is chaos until such time you can investigate and understand it - meanwhile you have all of your sunk cost bias of certainty tied up in **grandiose projects** of mass and actions all in place and planned to the nth degree. Chaos can also trick you into immediate action (panic faster) before enough time to question and hypothesize - which in my

comparison I think Eisenhower would have rated the lowest priority. "I have no time to investigate fully - let us just go with what we know now" - "we know all we need to know". We see this in smug journalists, ABC and everywhere whenever they get some information. This Rush to Judgement and Rush to Action. The smug certain binary dimwits.

Eisenhower's principle requires more context to be able to use. Is it important to proceed with our grand plans or more important to ask questions about the emerging chaos. I have heard feminists say "We have already had that argument" (groupthink/mobs - women are entitled victims) - to justify a continuing tyrannical corruption of everything they touch. "But marriages are down, suicides are up, 60% women in the public service - yet more work is to be done..." Nothing matters to them, no argument or question exists - they are tyrannically certain of their continuing abuse and corruption. 
So the confirmation bias is always for the believers - not the questioners - because - even if you believed in the mantra "always question the chaos" "always explore" - you would eventually have to come up with some kind of answer and choice of action. You justify your tyranny with the sunk cost bias "It is too late to stop now" - "we can't change tack mid stream".



People sometimes prefer to work in certain types of ways - have certain roles and responsibilities. This can vary through life experience and skills development.


Not too much dogma but there are patterns.

I have hypothesized relationships between Zipf type distributions to Gaussian type distributions - all things seem connected somehow - some things more strongly than others and I try to put each connection at the opposite ends of a continuum.


At one end of the continuum is A **Choice of action** type thing - an **event**. At the Other end is a kind of **"Thing"** - a coalesced instantiated thing with measurable and **observable** attributes. So there is definitely a concept - a general abstraction - of 2 - of pairs of things (e.g. events and things) - but I keep exploring what might be in the middle.

Fibonnaci is somehow there with chaos theory and probability/monty hall as a pattern of choice - a kind of step with a twist type approach we see as patterns in nature. **Tension is there too** - a pattern - a **necessary tension** like Ricci https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Einstein tensor tensors.



So what am I thinking out of kilter means?

I hypothesize a vague thing - something like this model below but I have a problem? because my normal distribution continuum is in the middle of the two extreme continuums of Zipf and Gauss. Is this my initial self reference and recursion? Does this mean that while things tend to normal distributions - actions of choice push things towards Zipf and a kind of Pareto distribution. Does Pareto represent a balanced and choice optimized (survival state) and the Gauss represent the chaotic universe (on average). I put the circle in the middle to represent a kind of flux and continuum of events, choices and actions - while the curve itself represents the frequency distributions of the kinds of choices actions and events. So when I notice things are awry - is the circle spinning tool fast? Are the wheels about to fall off?

Newtons 2nd Law of Thermodynamics

Initially I put him on the right and then the left - I suspect there are elements at both extremes - but I cannot be sure. All things being equal - space, energy, matter-means things are all the "same" in some sense but also every single thing is unconnected - closer to in some way - to any other thing.

At the extremes we have Zipf, Benford (and maybe Monty Hall as well? Or is it in the middle?) pushing towards popularity and limited popular choices and the doctrine of the mean, Newtons 2nd law, entropy, "on average", "equality" pushing towards a Gaussian, normal. In between we have Pareto (towards Zipf), Weibull (towards Zipf), Deming (maybe towards Gauss) https://deming.org/ and others.

Something in between in a kind of balanced way. Now this is **not dogmatic diversity** - yet some humans might see some commonality. Too much dogma and **too much attention** (by the lawyers and other expensive expert grafters, predictors, soothsayers) **damages the model** - the **observer effect**.

When everything is humming along it is best that you do not overly concentrate on minute details - it is best to let the thing explore and develop under its own volition. You don't want to throw a "spanner in the works".


We will need to notice and take on CHAOS when it emerges.

You need to notice - when it needs attention - and when to leave it be, like when it needs to see a doctor. Is there such a thing as a doctor of humanity? A tyrant - a deluded narcissistic sociopath? The certain "god" doctor?

This model converts into the cumulative distribution of all human capabilities, competency, skills, capacity, interest, knowledge, etc (i.e. **Not corrupted**).






They lack any awareness and fail to notice most things. Greed - money and power helps them stay cocooned.

They concentrate on themselves - their virtue - their inner beauty - you know - like those **grotesque humans who mutilate themselves** with plastic surgery and other procedures to publicly display their "beauty". They squint at their own reflections through "Rose Coloured glasses" - filtered view https://www.frontiersin.org/articles/10.3389/fnhum.2 019.00187/full



Zero is an Infinity

'If infinity exists then how many infinities do you have?' - Author(Jonathan Pearson) Year[2022] Keyword(Development Learning Individual)



I was talking with a friend about netineti. I need to explain the idea of zero more and how infinity works. If we notice how the Zipf turns into a zero based curve - we can use the example of the NOT idea - what is it when someone does not have a name? We call them "unknown" name and get a count of it - but what about the idea of Null from Fishers's 4 box model?

Zero becomes the infinite null case. Not definitely "unknown" (Monty Hall) but NULL

But **Zero may be different** (I will examine it) when looking at **Continuous/Quantitative** variables instead of **Nominal/Categorical/Qualitative** variables https://www.educba.com/types-of-variables/, https://www.educba.com/types-of-variables-in-statistics/

Things like Names (Nominal) - first names for humans in a selected group - frequency distributions (popularity/choice) tend to follow the Zipf curve - also words in a book.

It would be easy to confuse what type of variable you are looking at - for example with Benford's law https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Benford%27s_law - you are looking at numbers - numbers in bank account i.e. each entry in the bank account. Benford's law also applies to street addresses and phone numbers where the set is big enough and they have not been made too dogmatically or structured. This is not an easy concept to grasp but what you are really looking at is a Nominal variable - the variable has been named as a number digit (0-9). But more than that the variable has not been pulled continuously from the number line (i.e. a continuous variable) it can be viewed as digits in combination with each other in an ordered list. This first digit can be 0-9, the second digit can be 0-9 and so on. A Kind of Ten door infinite Monty Hall. Words would be a 26 door (alphabet) Monty Hall.

This is similar to, but not the same as, weight or height or speed, which tend to have a number associated with it which is pulled in order from the number line from 0 to infinity. A Continuous/Quantitative variable - measuring some "quality" of a thing.

A zero weight makes no sense - hence it is null, same for height but speed is a little more complex. I can declare a speed of zero - but absolute zero? The Car is not moving - the car is NOT/moving at Zero speed? The Car has travelled zero distance. Zero Time? Can I have zero distance but not zero time? At this point conceptually, we seem to be getting into **Einstein's relativity**. So it gets a little more complicated understanding and trying to explore what type of thing you are looking at and what you are describing with a frequency distribution. A Frame of reference becomes more important rather than simply a "Named" thing (Nominal variable). Logically this the declarative IS statement *That is named "Fred"* - a thing declared and named rather than measured.

Continuous/Quantitative things like weight and height tend to follow the Gaussian distribution. (On average) https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Normal_distribution **The Central Limit Theorem** https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Central limit theorem





The sum of the coefficients of (1 + x)n is obviously 2n so, if we divide the coefficients by 2n, the sum of the normalized coefficients of each polynomial will equal 1. Also, the coefficients are clearly symmetrical, and we can align the central values by shifting the n index by m/2. De Moivre noticed a remarkable fact about these normalized coefficients, namely, that if we scale the normalized coefficients by the square root of m, and scale the indices by the reciprocal of this square root, all the coefficients appear to lie on (or very close to) a single curve. The figure below shows the re-scaled coefficients for m = 4, 5, and 6.



Continuing on in this way, a plot of the normalized and re-scaled coefficients for the first 60 **binomial expansions** is shown below.



So another way of looking at this is the idea of ZIPF/Benford being around a **named single choice** and influences of concepts like **popularity**, availability bias and complacency (fat, dumb, lazy) and certain choice - and Normal /Gaussian distributions tend to be around **chance**, **probability**, complexity and multiple variables.

This tension between Popularity and the like and the chance/probability leaves us in the middle somewhere and may help explaining why Paul Erdos

https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Paul_Erd%C5%91s did not immediately understand Monty Hall choice probabilities because he was possibly biased towards one end of the choice continuum - Gaussian.

For the sake of the exercise we can shift the frame of Gaussian (and Pareto, Weibull and others) distribution to CENTRE AROUND THE AVERAGE - to make the mean the CENTRAL LIMIT POINT. We can call this ZERO and the measure the distances in each DIRECTION from the CENTRAL ZERO. https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Central limit theorem

So, I hypothesize that ZERO - for the bulk of statistical distributions - is really an infinity of nulls.

To Return to Fisher. A Review.

So I take the general 4 box model and **play with the abstraction** (many people struggle with abstraction) of choice in a binary outcome view. Two choices can become one choice **and** a NOT choice "1". i.e. we are abstracting away from a list of known choices (Monty Hall) into a single choice and the NOT - which in this case is an **infinity of SPECIFIC NOTs. This is part of what Fisher was doing when explaining the null hypothesis test.**

Longinus likened Demosthenes to a blazing thunderbolt and argued that he "perfected to the utmost the tone of lofty speech, living passions, copiousness, readiness, speed."[2] Quintilian extolled him as lex orandi ("the standard of oratory"). Cicero said of him that inter omnis unus excellat ("he stands alone among all the orators"), and also acclaimed him as "the perfect orator" who lacked nothing"

So we see with Cicero and Demosthenes a technique of debate and speech making which are strong examples of civil discourse. They are explorative and contextual. They respect the importance of civil discourse and debate. They prepared themselves and did their work before they spoke. https://penelope.uchicago.edu/Thayer/E/Roman/Texts/Plutarch/Lives/Demosthenes*.html "And there would seem to be strong proof of this in the fact that Demosthenes was rarely heard to speak on the spur of the moment, but though the people often called upon him by name as he sat in the assembly, he would not come forward unless he had given thought to the question and was prepared to speak upon it. 4 For this, many of the popular leaders used to rail at him, and Pytheas, in particular, once told him scoffingly that his arguments smelt of lamp-wicks. p21 To him, then, Demosthenes made a sharp answer. 5 "Indeed," said he, "thy lamp and mine, O Pytheas, are not privy to the same pursuits." To the rest, however, he made no denial at all, but confessed that his speeches were neither altogether unwritten, nor yet fully written out. 6 Moreover, he used to declare that he who rehearsed his speeches was a true man of the people: for such preparation was a mark of deference to the people, whereas heedlessness of what the multitude will think of his speech marks a man of oligarchical spirit, and one who relies on force rather than on persuasion "

The context of the situation is given, the speech maker declares their position and fairly deals with their own history and involvement in the matter before them. They try to recognize their own history of arguments and mistakes relating to the current issue. They try to explore the facts and history of the matter. They try to fairly deal with the person they are arguing against and explore alternatives and possible consequences - and they leave it to the audience to decide rather than shame, blame and coerce them into a decision. They are appealing to their civil nature - not their virtue - but a sense of proportion and fairness - a reason - for doing things. It is an exploration - and ideas of possibilities and hypothesis.

This is not the ends justifies the means or win at all costs approach.

Corruption - lies, nepotism, drug taking, hormones, magic elixirs https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Asterix the Gaul, stealing, bribing, unfair advantage, blood doping,

dressing up as a woman, keeping secrets, etc - all of these are exposed in the games. People can seek to play fairly in a character building ethos way or they can cheat and play unfairly.

Where there is a huge difference in people involved in the competition - then it becomes more of a dominance and tribal warfare thing than a game. That is why there are different grades of cricket. I remember playing under 16 (3rd grade) cricket and we were playing the grand final against another 16s side. They brought a young cricketer (15 years old) in from 1st grade district to play for the final against us - he had played first grade cricket with adults all year. We could not get him out - he scored all their runs and won the game for them.

The trophy means nothing.

The lessons mean everything.

I really have little care for the women's sport - transgender issue - it is just another example of the women are victims narrative and the greedy acquisition of fame and money.

Who cares? I mean - why be outraged? (18 C)

So, grade the swimming competitions into two grades - one for good swimmers and one for not so good swimmers - based on best times - like they do now. Or weight or height or age or ability. It has very little to do with identity, skin colour, tribe, etc.

Get rid of the huge money, fame, etc and recognize the importance of amateur sport. Give winners a sprig of rosemary to stick in the hair rather than bags of gold. Stop inflating the narcissistic, self centered, puffed up, celebrity hero "special human" category. Start appreciating ALL of the human condition and the point of "the games".

Roman emperors got rid of the plurality of deities - not only because of obsessive sacrifices and constant focus - but also they believed in a single God. It was **very popular** this single God idea - the **new thing**. The Jews and the Christians had single Gods and then later the Muslims came along with their single god and **wars took over for more than one thousand years**. **Certain gods of war** became the catch cry - blood flowed in the name of binary certain gods - briefly interrupted by Genghis Khan and some barbarian hordes from time to time.

The earlier humans - Akkadians, Sumerians, Greeks, Egyptians, Romans and many others had manifested chaos, and uncertainty into various forms - ghosts, trees, sun, sky, mountains, rivers, etc - and abstracted them away into complex stories of animals, figures *Venus of Willendorf* (-23000 BCE) https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Venus_of_Willendorf, human like creatures, deities, gods - there were families and fights and arguments - just like normal humans and power plays and everyone

seeking domination and control. These various gods could be abused and ridiculed - blamed for poor harvest, bad trade deals, barren wives, storms, floods - all manner of chaotic and uncertain events could be cast around amongst the gods of certainty and chaos. Discussions could be had - stories could be told - day to day competitions - gods fought amongst themselves and we could talk about the results (fires, famine, storms, wind, etc). **On ongoing internal dialogue with ourselves and discussions with others.**

But there was a push for binary certainty - grabbed eagerly by the binary certaintists. No man can have a peaceful life who thinks too much about lengthening it, or believes that living through many consulships is a great blessing. 5. Rehearse this thought every day, that you may be able to depart from life contentedly; for many men clutch and cling to life, even as those who are carried down a rushing stream clutch and cling to briars and sharp rocks."

XXXI. On Siren Songs 6. What then is good? The knowledge of things. What is evil? The lack of knowledge of things. Your wise man, who is also a craftsman, will reject or choose in each case as it suits the occasion; but he does not fear that which he rejects, nor does he admire that which he chooses, if only he has a stout and unconquerable soul. I forbid you to be cast down or depressed. It is not enough if you do not shrink from work; ask for it. 7. "But," you say, "is not trifling and superfluous work, and work that has been inspired by ignoble causes, a bad sort of work?" No; no more than that which is expended upon noble endeavours, since the very quality that endures toil and rouses itself to hard and uphill effort, is of the spirit, which says: "Why do you grow slack? It is not the part of a man to fear sweat." 8. And besides this, in order that virtue may be perfect, there should be an even temperament and a scheme of life that is consistent with itself throughout; and this result cannot be attained without knowledge of things, and without the art[3] which enables us to understand things human and things divine. That is the greatest good. If you seize this good, you begin to be the associate of the gods, and not their suppliant.

XXXVII. On Allegiance to Virtue .." 1. You have promised to be a good man; you have enlisted under oath; that is the strongest chain which will hold you to a sound understanding. Any man will be but mocking you, if he declares that this is an effeminate and easy kind of soldiering. I will not have you deceived. The words of this most honourable compact are the same as the words of that most disgraceful one, to wit:[1] "Through burning, imprisonment, or death by the sword." 2. From the men who hire out their strength for the arena, who eat and drink what they must pay for with their blood, security is taken that they will endure such trials even though they be unwilling; from you, that you will endure them willingly and with alacrity. The gladiator may lower his weapon and test the pity of the people;[2] but you will neither lower your weapon nor beg for life. You must die erect and unyielding. Moreover, what profit is it to gain a few days or a few years? There is no discharge for us from the moment we are born."

Seneca expresses many interesting ideas and discussions but is essentially binary in his thinking - he under represents (omission) the uncertainty and has **emphasized a certain "virtue"** and with that comes the smuglifuntism of the devout and those who refuse further development. They all ready have declared themselves "Good". See all the devout religious smuglifunts in politics and eleites all around the world. Their **first declaration in Life**, as sentient humans, (see Andrew Barr's drug riddled dogs) is "I am Good". Nero - like many after him (the current crop of Labour/Green/Feminist/Communist/Religious Zealot/Tribal - binary types) - had studied and learned a few things from a wise man - the universities of the time - had filled himself with smug certainty and certain self-righteousness - a **certain "good"** a **certain self virtue**.

He himself realised his mental infirmity, and thought at times of going into retirement and clearing his brain. It is thought that his wife Caesonia gave him a drug intended for a love potion, which however had the effect of driving him mad. 3 He was especially tormented with sleeplessness; for he never rested more than

three hours at night, and even for that length of time he did not sleep quietly, but was terrified by strange apparitions, once for example dreaming that the spirit of the Ocean talked with him. Therefore weary of lying in bed wide awake during the greater part of the night, he would now sit upon his couch, and now wander through the long colonnades, crying p483 out from time to time for daylight and longing for its coming."

A tyrannical, dictator and violent, abusive self-centered psychopath. Very reminiscent of the tyrannical deluded dictators we see in the Australian States and various nations around the world.

Then Nero - followed by a long list of Emperors and tyrants - some little more than just flawed humans - but many were dictatorial abusive tyrants - the delusional tyrannical psychopaths of our time.

The appalling behaviour of Roman elites was noticed by many and in many ways gave new impetus to Satura - satire https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Satire - which was gaining in popularity. 400 years before this time the Greeks had used comedy https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Aristophanes in their drama festivals.

I would fain flee to Sarmatia and the frozen Sea when people who ape the Curii 1 and live like Bacchanals dare talk about morals. In the first place, they are unlearned persons, though you may find their houses crammed with plaster casts of Chrysippus 2; for their greatest hero is the man who has bought a likeness of Aristotle or Pittacus, 3 or bids his shelves preserve an original portrait of Cleanthes.4 Men's faces are not to be trusted; does not every street abound in gloomy-visaged debauchees? And do you rebuke foul practices, when you are yourself the most notorious of the Socratic reprobates? A hairy body, and arms stiff with bristles, give promise of a manly soul: but the doctor grins when he cuts into the growths on your shaved buttocks. Men of your kidney talk little; they glory in taciturnity, and cut their hair shorter than their eyebrows. Peribomius 5 himself is more open and more honest; his face, his walk, betray his distemper, and I charge Destiny with his failings. Such men excite your pity by their frankness; the very fury of their passions wins them pardon. Far worse are those who denounce evil ways in the language of a Hercules; and after discoursing upon virtue, prepare to practise vice. "Am I to respect you, Sextus," quoth the ill-famed Varillus, "when you do as I do? How am I worse than yourself? "Let the straight-legged man laugh at the clubfooted, the white man at the blackamoor: but who could endure the Gracchi railing at sedition? Who will not confound heaven with earth, and sea with sky, if Verves denounce thieves, or Milo 6 cutthroats? If Clodius condemn adulterers, or Catiline upbraid Cethegus 7; or if Sulla's three disciples 8 inveigh against proscriptions? Such a man was that adulterer 9 who, after lately defiling himself by a union of the tragic style, revived the stern laws that were to be a terror to all men----ay, even to Mars and Venus---at the moment when Julia was relieving her fertile womb and giving birth to abortions that displayed the similitude of her uncle. Is it not then right and proper that the very worst of sinners should despise your pretended Scauri,10 and bite back when bitten?"

The Binary certaintists need to have "One Ring to Rule them all" - someone ultimately responsible - because they cannot handle the concept of initial self-reference and recursion - they had to create a final beginning and a final end to things. The Binary thinkers - See

(many before that back to simple paintings, carvings and idols found in caves of even sentient homo erectus) But what we see in the massive Asia/Europe/Africa land mass is large movement of people, trade and ideas - a constant intermingling as the climate warmed - groups which had been separated for so long by the cold and ice - were intermingling again. The settled tribes in warmer fertile lands, lands of 'Milk and Honey" (

with the hardy camels in the deserts.

Zoroaster https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Zoroaster (-2000 - Central/Western Asia) - maybe? associated with https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Andronovo culture Andronova culture. A mixture of camel traders, nomadic equestrian tribes and Turkic culture

Wilson in his PHD thesis recently takes some notice of this

If you are in the middle of a vibrant trading network of different cultures and new ideas (and potential killers) - Tolerance, Hypothesis, Debate and Learning - might develop as useful and profitable survival mechanisms. You might have to engage with things and develop.

Following the philosophy became more and more dogmatic - a **religion of certainty** - each one more special than the other - more enlightened, more knowledgeable - "closer to the one god of certainty". It's easier that way - I hate having to debate. It is the way we do things around here. Everybody does it says Gladys. I'm no worse than Hitler - says everyone else. **Fat, Dumb, Lazy**

Gautama Buddha (-500 Ganges/Nepal/India) came along with ideas, thoughts, writings and temples with statues - so ideas could be "worshipped". He had ideas about being human as well but the temple worship became the main focus. All very human and embracing the "flux" and aware of the initial self-reference and recursion problems (as the Hindus also had done). Buddhism flowed down India into Sri Lanka and then out into the trading lanes in south-east Asia and into China.

The ideas came from a man, the man became the statue, the statue became the temple, the temple became the religion, the religion became the certain dogma, the dogma became the smug habit.

Chinese Buddhists went on pilgrimages to the center of Buddhism in Nepal - firstly on the main trade routes north and then down into Pakistan and across the base of the Himalayas - but then later across the top of South East Asia - Thailand, Laos, Cambodia and Burma. Burma exploded into temples and provided an alternative travel route for the Indians and Chinese, Japanese, Koreans - a religious pilgrimage and trade route. So what had been small farming communities of many tribal cultures spread across fertile valleys of South East Asia - became trade hubs and religious centers. Within 1200 years Buddhist temples were everywhere in south East Asia, China, Korea and Japan and daily worship ingrained. Flavours of Buddhism developed and changed for each region - there were choices of certainty. The Pacific islands and many parts of Indonesia were generally unaffected by these religions. Africa, the Americas - the Aztecs - had made up their own deities and were unaware of the gods of certainty being pedaled through the trade routes.

Virtue signaling the binary certain dogma became widespread - smuglifuntism was growing.

So there was this tendency to downplay "By Jove!" the "minor" gods of agriculture, trade, fertility, fear, war, storms, earthquakes, etc - and make everything a **one certain god** - **And** - With that came more power, dogma (the Pharisees and their scribes), profits, "being reverered **for being close to the certain god** (smuglifuntism)", and the constant propaganda of certain belief and the **blasphemy of questioning** the one certain god. "How dare you question (me) the one true certainty." Laws were made by the rulers of the day - initially tolerant of multiplicity of deities in all various city states which were being ruled - but then becoming less tolerant over time. A **decay of tolerance** (fat, dumb, lazy) into smuglifuntism.

The one certain God idea (*Ahura Mazda*) https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Ahura_Mazda - a kind of "Certain wisdom" - and also binary good/bad - started becoming more popular probably with Zoroaster as the "prophet" https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Zoroaster,

The Binary certain problem of death was handled in different ways by different religions - Some promoted an infinite happy "afterlife" (balanced in a binary way by infinite hell - after all, what is happiness without hell?) - happy ever after infinite existence - heaven, nirvana, utopian dreams - others, particularly Buddhism and Hinduism - promoted Reincarnation https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Reincarnation most likely because this aligned with the continuous flux idea - a continuum - but because they still needed binary certainty they invented binary certain "lifespans" which start and end - kind of like a transfinite mathematical concept (set theory, etc) or an infinite monty hall door choice (always with greater prizes to be discovered). So they chose a certain infinity of "lifespans" rather than the certain infinite "afterlife" to ease their anxiety about initial self-reference and recursion.

The early rules for societies were like "Thalt shalt not" - defining the selected bad things and the punishments for them - a kind of keeping the peace approach rather than a virtue signal of "goodness". The Jews and the Christians - notably through the conversions of binary minded people to the "the binary certain cause" (through people like Saul/Paul and the other religious zealots) - started to dominate and control the lives of people on a day to day basis - in the kind of totalitarian authoritarianism dogmatic way we see in societies all over the world. The Fire magic of Zoroastians wasn't enough to impress the gullible and anxious - "miracles" were invented - God was magically all powerful - not just an excuse for failing to comprehend uncertainty, complexity, initial self-reference and recursion.

Then blind adherence to the binary certain faith became everything - those in control determined what reality was to be taught and believed on a daily basis. "No other gods before me" "false idols" "pagans" - as intolerance and certain truth was mandated. The Church was the ministry of truth and certainty. Witches, sorcerers and Magicians were being replaced by Magic wielding Gods. Religions of certainty - and all the profiteering Pharisees and scribes - became widespread and powerful business.

Constantine https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Constantine the Great (272 to 337) warred across Europe and set the scene for advancing the Christian Religion, which he embraced, to create a new Byzantine era - centered on **Byzantium**/Constantinople/Instanbul - Not Rome. What started as tolerance for all - beliefs and religions became dominance and binary certainty for the selected religions - the "Right religions".

Was there a trinity or not - what colour clothes does God wear - If god really loved me would he give me everything I want? Do I have to sacrifice more - what is the right amount to sacrifice. Is heaven warm or will I need to pack clothes and do I need to take my own gold, jewels, baubles, bangles and trinkets? The Jewish and Christian leader's one god was powerful and a very good way to get money and power for those who sold this certainty and demanded faithful allegiance.

Gods were not optional any more.

The first rule of religion is you must have a religion and it must be ours. (tribal mobs, binary)

Sacrifice to Gods became profits for the Pharisees and Scribes.

Laws became more and more codified in favour of Jews and Christians - especially by the Romans - religious ones were exempt of Taxes (like in many countries now - selected religions (the right ones) are constantly subsidized by taxpayers) and exempted from responsibilities in society ("confessions to crimes" was an "internal matter") - doing certain tasks (serving in war and defense of the nation, do certain jobs (*it is beneath me and my beliefs* - i.e. religious intolerance - codified in law) etc) and became more and more special. This was a reversal (binary switch) from Nero's time several hundred years before. "Pagans" was a term invented to demonize the "others" - the non-Jews and non-Christians.

"Certainty available here - come get your certain certainty on a stick - it is free - get an easy anxiety free life (certain good for ever) - nothing up front - just a lifetime of sacrifice and profit for me - the giver of certainty. Smuglifuntism guaranteed"

For several hundred years up to **Theodosius II** and his father before him - the Romans were changing the laws of the empire to be more about religion and special humans rather than fair dealing and trade - the dogma was becoming more totalitarian and Gods of certainty were involved. The Olympic Games and other festivals declined (No public holidays, no time off for some - only for the special elites - the emperors, their friends, Jews and Christians). Sacrifices of expensive chickens became mandated for the certain gods of the power and empire - the elites. We see this now as binary extremism, communism, fascism, socialism, feminism, religious zealotry, virtue signaling and the entitled victim narrative leading to a declaration of certain "good" (God of certainty) - "diversity", "inclusion", "equality", "justice" - **new gods of certainty** - **as there will always be**.

".. For in the case of the majority of **men in power** their very **inexperience** always causes the imitation of the base actions of their predecessors to be easy" ("that's the way we do things around here - sunk cost corruption"), "and they ever turn with greater ease and facility to the faults committed by the rulers of an earlier time. 8 But after I was brought to write my history of these events by the thought that it will assuredly p7 be clear to those who hereafter shall hold sovereign power that, in the first place, punishment will in all probability overtake them likewise for their misdeeds, just as befell these persons; and, in the second place, that their own actions and characters will likewise be on record for all future time, so that consequently they will perhaps be more reluctant to transgress. 9 For what man of later times would have learned of the licentious life of Semiramis or of the madness of Sardanapalus and Nero, if the records of these things had not been left behind by the writers of their times? And apart from these considerations, in case any should chance to suffer like treatment at the hands of their rulers, this record will not be wholly useless to them. 10 For those who have suffered misfortunes are wont to receive consolation from the thought that not upon themselves alone have cruel disasters fallen.3 For these reasons, then, I shall proceed to relate, first, all the base deeds committed by Belisarius; and afterwards I shall disclose all the base deeds committed by Justinian and Theodora."

The disruption and disintegration of the Roman Empire was a herald call to those who wanted to inflict their certainty on others. Probably - things like "unknown plagues of death" - increased the power of the certain god sellers - across Europe

The Muslims (700s) outdid the intolerance of Jews and Christians with "death to unbelievers" - the certainty became deadly NOT ONLY to those who questioned or disagreed (Blasphemers) - but those who failed to publicly constantly declare their belief in the "the faith" (Heretics)- "the certain cause".

Death to those who strand (stranded/stand) up to the certain Mob!

Kings, Emperors and tribal leaders were sometimes revered as gods and trusted to make decisions for the group - but now the religious groups - the devout - the virtuous - demanded the power instead of the just - the competent and the trusted. Virtue, not competence - started to dominate. "we are all human and make mistakes" became the criticism of humans - only the "devout" had the answers suitable for the God of certainty. "God works in certain mysterious ways", "MY god knows"

Over many centuries - other binary certain zealots then wrestled with this **power, money** and **control** - the Muslims, Buddhists, Hindus, etc - all the binary religious zealots - because the Romans had modeled **a society where laws of society were mixed with laws of religion** - this **combined model of social and religious laws** and the installation of certain gods - became the model for societies across the world - "It is my God given right to kill you" - said the binaries tribal types - no longer a crime of single person - it became a **god endorsed massacre and abuse**. A crusade - a conversion - a righteous cause - a savior (certain death). **Instant smug judgement.**

More miraculous certainty.

Exploring the Single Rant

I have asked many people "what were you thinking" - asked Gordon Ramsay, all the A.C.T. politicians, the ABC board, management and staff, other journalists, all the politicians in local and national government, A.C.T. Magistrates court and staff, many public servants and many of my friends.

They just ignore you or grunt some tribal virtue signal in a smug pig-ignorant way.

So this ability not to rant about what they think or what words they say and write - to me - seems utterly deluded.

A recent Facebook discussion one of my friends virtue signaled how good it is that women are allocated jobs and positions ahead of men. This is a common theme around the world and is specifically mandated in Legislation and organizations and very popular (it seems). World-wide mandated groupthink and corruption. **Amanda Stoker** regularly posts things about how great it is that women get special treatment and money from government and business merely for being

women and how proud she is in here role in promoting and encouraging this. I post back the words "Bigot - why are you so proud of your bigotry, groupthink and corruption?" - I get no reply, not even "It is my Job - I am proud at how well I do in my job" (said the train diver to Auschwitz https://www.auschwitz.org/en/)

"Proud bigot and corrupt" - groupthink, group identity and nepotism based on group characteristics - the "in-group" - the very definition of corruption.

Now, these words I use I consider a reasonably accurate assessment of the behaviour of the person - they are behaving like this. It is not name calling or abuse - but a fairly specific description. For example I am not directly calling them a vague term like an "idiot" or a "smuglifunt" - although I will admit there are idiots and smuglifunts in the world - in my conversation with them - there is no point to calling them names - only to try to describe the behaviours and ideas.

I can support my words with context and examples and discussion. We can discuss it.

"Why do you think grouping individuals based on identity characteristics is a good idea?"

And so on - step by step - inch by inch down some kind of logically connected and **coherent** path.

So they grunt the virtue signal and I ask "what were you thinking?"

This is one of the most threatening things you can do to the pig-ignorant smuglifunts who dominate the world at the moment. "HOW DARE YOU QUESTION ME" they scream back with violent intent rousing the tribe of followers.

Recently, though I was able to get one of my Facebook virtue signaling friends to examine the facts that 60% (up from 40%) of the public service is women based on positive discrimination and groupthink - this is celebrated by politicians the public service commission. He posted back yes but women represent 40% of senior public servants - so in other words - women are still victims of toxic white male discrimination despite constant legislated and mandated discrimination for women in every job and every position - including mandatory quotas. Men are still the devil and women are the victims - declares the binary hero.

Now there is no hint of being aware of any logic or coherence problem with anything he is saying. Eventually he states "Discrimination is good, sometimes".

Here the argument is - "the best way to stop alleged discrimination is to discriminate openly and constantly". Not only hypocrisy - but entrenched incoherence (every thing invested in self - initial self reference is himself - what ever he says whenever he feels like it - his "opinion")

He then demands I prove why only 40% of women are in senior positions. (Like it is my fault or the fault of the group that he assigned me to belong to - "Toxic White Males") This is similar to the idea of "prove yourself innocent of my biased and bigoted assumptions" as men have to do in A.C.T. Magistrates courts, family Law, universities, schools and the ABC and other media. So instead of him having to justify his corruption and bigotry he **expects me to prove** why he should **not be** a corrupt bigot and supporter of corruption and groupthink.

So I say - "Well it might be toxic white male unconscious bias by the few males left in the public service or it could infinitely **more complex than that** - so many more things than the idea of diving to single perpetrator a **single binary certain "devil"."**

So not only does he omit to notice 60% women - he emphasizes one selected statistic 40% - and then asks me to explain it.

So some of the problems here is "well, its more complicate than that - the pareto principle, weibull other factors, etc - and why mandate 50% anyway when you think 60% is "equality" " - and the incoherence in that ..

- We get the **general problem** - "well if **you cannot explain it** then my belief - **my gods of certainty** - and the virtue that I fill myself with when I support these gods of certainty - **MUST BE the binary certain answer.** (to the problem that I invented)"

Now I can rant about this and many other things because I have done a lot of reading, writing, thinking, exploring, examining, etc and I have put these rants to many people and got nothing back. I know I am on to something - not because - I am receiving rapturous applause from some Mob - but the very opposite - **complete silence and avoidance** - at best, personal name calling but not dealing with or addressing the issue in any way. We see this **doubling down of pig-ignorance** in the media (ABC) the A.C.T. Magistrates court, A.C.T. and Commonwealth Human rights agencies, nearly all of the politicians I have written to. Most of my friends just go mute (with a very few exceptions).

I am noticing the writing of those people who really have something to say - looks a little like rant - at least in some of it's forms - in other forms it is poetry, plays, music, etc.

So when Tanya Plibersek or Penny Wong or some dimwit journalist says "Why do you have a problem with Women" - don't' say "Fuck off bigot and promoter of corruption" - because that would be rude and they would not understand because they are binary and have no idea how stupid they are - they are from the less developed tribes.



The two person debate - if done well, is not only interesting and educational - but enjoyable. Some people call it fighting or arguing. Greeks and Romans did it and many developed great skills.

I find that when discussing something with someone - that I find new things in me which I have not thought of - new ideas and words which I have to use to try to express myself. I find too that the


other person is also doing it. I enjoy this new discovery process and I like the idea that they are doing it too - that we are **both discovering things** - that we have similar views on some things but different ideas on others. I enjoy it and it helps me to develop. I do more research and have to think, explore, hypothesize and discover new things. The ideas become separated abstracted away from the individual and inhabit a space between us where we can poke, prod, make fun of, ridicule, disagree with, hate, like, understand, not understand, etc - a shared hypothesis space of discussion - rather than - win at all costs - the ends justifies the means - of the binary certaintists.

This not a **Confucian ritual** or **habitual dance** - this is a spontaneous pair discussion which might be planned - a time given to have general discussion - a "catch-up" in a healthy relationship - "what are we both missing?" or an **unplanned explosion of ideas** and concerns.

To tribal binary types - this type of heightened dialogue of disagreement and exploration - even as only a witness to skilled people having the dialogue in front of them - is a threat to their smug caves of certain tribalism. It upsets them - they become offended (18C) and they want legislation passed and courts to punish people to protect them from offence.

Positioning the Lie

Feminists, Communists, Religious zealots, binary extremists and deluded psychopaths use the Focus model almost unconsciously - it is a model which applies to them but they do not understand it is a frame and how to explore the frame and adopt a **wider focus** and **zoom**.



You see them concentrating on Self, emphasizing some things, omitting others, avoiding complexity and rushing to simplistic models, making everything immediate and urgent and using "lived experience examples" or selected specifics. They don't understand or care what they are doing even if you show this model to them. A kind of narcissistic deluded sate - a self hypnosis where entire fantasy worlds can be created. A Permanent lie state - zombie mind.

Self hypnosis or Pavlovian propaganda state.

40% men in the entire public service is **not discrimination against men** but 40% women in senior positions in the public service is **discrimination against women**????? Doublethink, a delusion, - not just hypocrisy but entrenched incoherence we see in Penny Wong, Tanya Plibersek, - all the Labour and Greens women, ABC, all media, police, courts, politicians in general, school teachers, universities, women (on average), weak minded men, etc - a constant lie. The debate is stalled - maybe they are not ready - maybe they cannot control themselves - but how to help explore - when is the time "right" to have the discussions - the shared rant?

I need more time? I need more research? There is no rush to learning - all in good time? When the time is right? I am not ready, yet.

I notice that people understand things I am trying to say after reading it and re-reading it many times and allowing some time to pass. Then they can re-formulate the ideas in their own words and repeat it in their own context - not verbatim - not a tribal chant of fixed words - but with individual meaning for them. This seems like progress to me - some kind of shared understanding and create further questions to be explore.

So the lie is not really a lie - just a delay so time and experiences can grow. Thoughts can emerge. "Nothing is wrong" can be just a timing issue rather than a lie.

For how can I resist the attack not only of the uninformed multitude, but even of those who assume the character of politicians, while both will exclaim that our ferocious rage was not satiated by murdering, with unparalleled cruelty, an innocent youth, but exhibited a new example of barbarity in the persecution of women, a sex that is spared even by hostile armies at the capture of cities? From what horror, indeed, will any dignity or any majesty deter men who are guilty of such outrage to their princes? After these enormities, whom will justice, morality, law, respect for sovereignty or reverence for legal magistracy, restrain through shame or check through fear? When the exercise of the supreme executive power is become the ridicule of the lowest rabble, when trampling upon every distinction between right and wrong, between honour and dishonour, men degenerate, almost by common consent, into savage barbarity. To these and still more

atrocious charges I know that I shall be forced, upon my return to France, to listen, as the ears of all have in the meantime been so thoroughly shut as to be susceptible of no apology, nor even of a satisfactory defence."

The idea of **limiting power over others** - because it tended to corruption (binaries, feminists, greedy, corrupt, psychopaths, etc) - has been around for a long time.

People have tried to document ideas and methods to help city states, rulers, kings, tyrants, tribal elders, etc - behave themselves in a human kind of way.

The current discussion of a republic instead of a constitutional democratic monarchy is a good example. The question is how to get a decent balance of power - especially with binary certain tyrants tend to want to control everything. How to ensure a **necessary tension and debate** with those who are so certain of everything.

A brief hypothesis is that the idea of a tyrannical king on earth who can wield almighty power, as a last resort, when the system starts to completely fall apart, is an idea based on the red button certainty - the certain knowledge of a final nihilist button that seems to provoke a reaction and some thought. Those close to the tyrannical psychopaths and persuade them and change the course of events - humanity seems to emerge under extreme stresses. A daily reminder of the certain Red Button might be good technique to remind people - sometimes ritualized - and maybe celebrated. The almighty power is never used - but is in plain sight and conversations can be had - it is manifested in some kind of "reality check" in the form of a King or Queen of certainty and power - but not involved in daily decisions.

Allowing too much power to centralize is a not a good idea.

Learning to read and understand

If you re-read the same book at different stages of your life you will see the contents differently each time. This is because **you have changed** - not the book.

The initial connections and links you make with ideas is limited to your frames. As you read your frames and ideas grow - your schemas develop. You get many schemas and links and you understand the references and links - you understand the meaning of the words you understand the intent of the author - what they were trying to convey - the messages and ideas - you get an insight into the person who wrote the messages. You get greater context of the human condition. This is not a process of building dogmatic certainty - this is a process of building coherent and comprehensive hypothesis.

"Jack and Jill went up the Hill to fetch a pail of water, Jack fell down, and broke his crown and Jill came tumbling after"

Many people have written long and detailed analysis of this simple nursery rhyme for their PHD thesis - of course, the **feminists** would question why a woman had to always do domestic chores and was Jill's *tumbling down after* due to Jack? Was Jill a victim of Jack's interference, dominance, incompetence and controlling attitudes?

So have an appropriate and useful frame - when to go into deep analysis and when to leave it as simple abstractions - **how much work to do to understand?**

Early on, you rush through things because you are absorbing vast amounts of information - collection - a kind of bower bird or a search algorithm (Paul Levy Flights https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/L%C3%A9vy_flight) - it enables a large contextual high level abstraction - a layout of the land - a Map of Meaning (see Jordon Peterson).

With high levels initially established lower levels can be explored in more detail and then higher levels can be re-adjusted (changing frames of reference). Structures/Schemas change also.

Traversing this mental landscape takes a lifetime and is always changing. At later stages - I can accommodate vast connected networks of loosely structured information pathways where I have a greater ability to recognize new ideas and insights while being more able to quickly and accurately discard information less needed to be "noticed" - but - constantly aware of smug complacency - "What Am I Missing? What have I failed to notice?"

I am unaware of how exactly much I don't know - but I can examine the works of others to try to find out.

I can scan documents to see how "dense" or "structured" they are - whether they contain detailed database type information with many schemas and frames or they are a narrative flow of ideas - like a song or light poem of lyrical ideas woven together.

If you don't understand people sometimes you think they are ignorant or barbarians so there is a **responsibility and accountability to try to communicate** with "OTHER HUMANS" - no matter how difficult it might be initially. See https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Mleccha **Mleccha** "referring to those of an incomprehensible speech,[1] later foreign or barbarous peoples"

I read everything and I arrogantly expect to be able to read and understand most things. Hence the expression "Oh you would not understand this" - I take as complete failing to the arrogant smartarse who blames me for the lack of ability to explain what they are thinking to other humans.

We see this in the "Mean Girls", Feminists and women (on average - quotas/mobs/tribes) and other binary types - especially in places like politics and the Labour Party and the Greens - where they all sit in rooms together smiling and baring their teeth - nodding at each other (some even nod at themselves when they speak - their reflection - their image - narcissists) no matter what sounds come of their mouths or words they write - and usually demonizing and pointing at "others", usually men, in a demeaning/tribal/abusive and violent way. At best this is some kind of shared tribal signal - this is what this tribe does when it demonizes or kills "others" - these are the shared rituals, sounds, songs, dances of glee - that we - (the tribe/mob) use when we kill people. This the way we do things around here - says the tribe (A.C.T. Magistrates court, Melbourne courts, police, politicians, staffers, ABC, Guardian, Feminists, public services and charities (for women), etc)

It is not communication - it is a simple tribal war-dance. For tribes and binaries - this is all the communication they know.

"Read" my language - I am going to Kill you.

So once we get past that tribal killing and smug ignorance (Canberra Magistrates, politicians, feminists, weak-mined sentient pet men, smuglifunts, Binary zealots, tribal warriors, etc) we can start to explore communication.

We can learn to read and write things. We can read other things and write our own things. Saying words outwards and aloud or writing words - giving voice to our ideas - helps human development (ours firstly but others as well).

When I write things I realize that people will judge me. I realize that people might think I am stupid. I realize that they can choose to engage or conversation or not. There are many choices.

Not many historical Authors explicitly tell people how to read their books. At best they provide some initial structure - maybe headings, chapters, summaries, indexes, reference lists - a kind of structure which morphs and develops over time. They are constantly experimenting with the form and structure of their communication.

Kierkegaard was one exception - he tells people to read his books through twice.

Form and structure moved through art, poems, drama, sayings, sculpture, music, dance, maths, philosophy, maps, plans, legislation, hierarchies, computer programs, schematics, language, symbols, etc.

I take it for granted (assume) that I can read all these things. I assume a can read everything. I don't assume I can understand it - but I do assume I can map sense of the information - that I can "parse" the information without necessarily seeing all the connections or understanding all the meanings.


I assume that if I went up to ship captain he could explain his detailed charts to me. He is a professional and knows what he is doing and can share it withers to learn.

This is a **BIG assumption** based on practice and learning. I can read dictionaries because I have read dictionaries. I can read maps because I have read maps and make maps. I can read manuals because I have read and written manuals. I can read music because I have read music, sung and played instruments. I can read and understand legislation, business cases, languages, forms, statistics, computer programs, formulas, chemical formulas, philosophy, accounts, instruction manuals, banking transactions, databases, client systems, Architectural drawings, publicity documents,

poems, novels, plays, musical scores, paintings, movies, sculpture, mime (on stage at Canberra theatre), dance, etc - because I have done most of these things - at least to level where I can "parse" the information and because I have in many cases written and created my own versions of these things (at least an initial try at it - not perfect - not certain) - and have some understanding of the thinking process, what is involved and what issues and problems there are when doing it. I am not too afraid of stuffing up or making a fool of myself.

Who tells the beginning artist and painter to stop painting and give up after the first attempt? Have you seen how much work Picasso did?

At the heart of this is the cooperation idea - **communication** and **cooperation** - an agreement to work on the frames, structures and process for communications. There is a "standard" and structure - a "frame" - enough to communicate - but not too much to stop creativity and exploration - enough to provide **certain homogeneity** of information while allowing a **heterogeneous accommodation** of variation. Men usually (on average) **expect this kind of standard meta structure** - "where are the schematics, where are the manuals, where are the codes, where are the code sheets, where are the dictionaries, where is the list of symbols, etc"



If I can find (take responsibility) and understand the frame - and then I can explore (take accountability and learn) the information and communication.

I can make more sense of What a Roman poet writes because I have done some work - I have mapped the landscape, history, wars, people, documents, buildings, language, etc - at that time and place - I have built some context.

I can re-read Nietzsche and see what he meant and why he was writing - the more I understand of the events, time and place. I can explore the Human Condition. As I learn more I can learn more from reading the same books as well as different books.

A Lesson on Appeasement

The thing to note with this declaration is that the Pharisees and scribes - the binary certain extremists - feminists, women (on average) the mobs - the groupthink - have **changed the fundamental meaning of this document** - by inserting exceptions and additional clauses by way of explanation. Some level to get **basic agreement**.

But then the binaries say "what does distinction mean?" - a fair question - I mean why put in the words "without distinction" unless you were trying to add value.

Now, one response to this is to say "All Individuals" **is the focus** - not the *distinctions*. But you see this is the very point the profiteers - the legal scumbags and binaries - the dogma police and their grafters, grafters and smug certaintists - they come on and say "Oh, we will tell you exactly how the world should be - Here is what "distinction" means" - or at least a list of **SOME EXAMPLES** OF IT.

And possibly this illustrated a saying uttered by one of the Peripatetic philosophers in earlier times, to the effect that the most opposite elements are found in man's nature, just as in mixed colours. 24 (I am now writing, however, of matters in which I have not been able to attain competency.) These faults and many others still greater he manifestly possessed to a p101 degree not in accord with human nature. On the contrary, Nature seemed to have removed all baseness from the rest of mankind and to have concentrated it in the soul of this man. 28 And in addition to his other shortcomings, while he was very easy-going as to lending an ear to slanders, yet he was severe as to inflicting punishment. For he never paused for a thorough investigation before reaching a decision, but straightway upon hearing what the slanderer said, he would make his decision and order it published. 29 And he did not hesitate to write orders that called for the capture of towns and the burning of cities and the enslavement of whole peoples, for no reason whatever."

Praising the Tribal Grunt

Tribalism and herd instinct are later forms of a binary fight/flight - which in-turn is a fundamental the universe - at least as far as the investigations of math, science, philosophy, etc can show us. The question is - why is there anything at all between the binaries? - or between the binary in general?

It is unsurprising that Twitter, Facebook and other **rush to communicate systems** - have lead to greater tribal activity. Sitting down to have a long conversation, mulling things over for a while, doing some research, has been replaced by a **rush to tribal grunting**. The kind of grunting and grooming noises we see in apes, herds and creatures of all kinds - this need to communicate a tribal signal.

But then a trader comes in with a bag of apples - enough for everyone to try - he eats the apple and then the trader grunts good, good, good (sharing the language of the tribe). The tribe recognize the signal and cautiously try the apple one by one - some grunt good other grunt bad - then it is about choice - some grunters prefer mastodon other grunters prefer apples.

Good, Good, Good - grunt, grunt, grunt (the apes, chimps - all the tribal creatures on earth - grunt, grunt, grunt) - becomes dance, poetry, songs, chants, slogans - the religious and compelling grunts - the tribe and how important the tribe is - the special ones of the tribe compared to the others. The praise to the Good mastodon food becomes the carving of the bones, the cave paintings, the icons, the abstracted symbols the memories and reminders of the good food - this is grunted every day in praise of the good. Gosh, we like mastodons - "and fire" someone else pipes up - yes all things good - we praise all good things - All Things Bright and Beautiful are praised - the poisoned apples are the devil's work and must be shunned and killed - says the tribe.

For each government has a peculiar character which originally formed and which continues to preserve it. The character of democracy creates democracy, and the character of oligarchy creates oligarchy; and always the better the character, the better the government.

Again, for the exercise of any faculty or art a previous training and habituation are required; clearly therefore for the practice of virtue. And since the whole city has one end, it is manifest that education should be one and the same for all, and that it should be public, and not private- not as at present, when every one looks after his own children separately, and gives them separate instruction of the sort which he thinks best; the **training in things which are of common interest should be the same** for all. Neither must we suppose that any one of the citizens belongs to himself, for they all belong to the state, and are **each of them a part of the state**, and the care of each part is inseparable from the care of the whole. In this particular as in some others the Lacedaemonians are to be praised, for they take the greatest pains about their children, and make education the business of the state."..." Of

those states which in our own day seem to take the greatest care of children, some aim at producing in them an athletic habit, but they only injure their forms and stunt their growth. Although the Lacedaemonians have not fallen into this mistake, yet they brutalize their children by laborious exercises which they think will make them courageous. But in truth, as we have often repeated, education should not be exclusively, or principally, directed to this end. And even if we suppose the Lacedaemonians to be right in their end, they do not attain it. For among barbarians and among animals courage is found associated, not with the greatest ferocity, but with a gentle and lion like temper. There are many races who are ready enough to kill and eat men, such as the Achaeans and Heniochi, who both live about the Black Sea; and there are other mainland tribes, as bad or worse, who all live by plunder, but have no courage. It is notorious that the Lacedaemonians themselves, while they alone were assiduous in their laborious drill, were superior to others, but now they are beaten both in war and gymnastic exercises. For their ancient superiority did not depend on their mode of training their youth, but only on the circumstance that they trained them when their only rivals did not. Hence we may infer that what is noble, not what is brutal, should have the first place; no wolf or other wild animal will face a really noble danger; such dangers are for the brave man. And parents who devote their children to gymnastics while they neglect their necessary education, in reality vulgarize them; for they make them **useful to the art of statesmanship** in one quality only, and even in this the argument proves them to be inferior to others. We should judge the Lacedaemonians not from what they have been, but from what they are; for now they have rivals who compete with their education; formerly they had none.'

Socrates - GLAUCON

And thus, Glaucon, after the argument has gone a weary way, the true and the false philosophers have at length appeared in view.

I do not think, he said, that the way could have been shortened.

I suppose not, I said; and yet I believe that we might have had a better view of both of them if the discussion could have been confined to this one subject and if there were not many other questions awaiting us, which he who desires to see in what respect the life of the just differs from that of the unjust must consider.

And what is the next question? he asked.

Surely, I said, the one which follows next in order. Inasmuch as philosophers only are able to grasp the eternal and unchangeable, and those who wander in the region of the many and variable are not philosophers, I must ask you which of the two classes should be the rulers of our State?

And how can we rightly answer that question?

Whichever of the two are best able to guard the laws and institutions of our State --let them be our quardians.

Very good.

Neither, I said, can there be any question that the guardian who is to keep anything should have eyes rather than no eyes?

There can be no question of that.

And are not those who are verily and indeed wanting in the knowledge of the true being of each thing, and who have in their souls no clear pattern, and are unable as with a painter's eye to look at the absolute truth and to that original to repair, and having perfect vision of the other world to order the laws about beauty, goodness, justice in this, if not already ordered, and to guard and preserve the order of them --are not such persons, I ask, simply blind?

Socrates - ADEIMANTUS

Here Adeimantus interposed and said: To these statements, Socrates, no one can offer a reply; but when you talk in this way, a strange feeling passes over the minds of your hearers: They fancy that they are led astray a little at each step in the argument, owing to their own want of skill in asking and answering questions; these littles accumulate, and at the end of the discussion they are found to have sustained a mighty overthrow and all their former notions appear to be turned upside down. And as unskilful players of draughts are at last shut up by their more skilful adversaries and have no piece to move, so they too find themselves shut up at last; for they have nothing to say in this new game of which words are the counters; and yet all the time they are in the right. The observation is suggested to me by what is now occurring. For any one of us might say, that although in words he is not able to meet you at each step of the argument, he sees as a fact that the votaries of philosophy, when they carry on the study, not only in youth as a part of education, but as the pursuit of their maturer years, most of them become strange monsters, not to say utter rogues, and that those who may be considered the best of them are made useless to the world by the very study which you extol.

Well, and do you think that those who say so are wrong?

I cannot tell, he replied; but I should like to know what is your opinion.

Hear my answer; I am of opinion that they are quite right.

Then how can you be justified in saying that cities will not cease from evil until philosophers rule in them, when philosophers are acknowledged by us to be of no use to them?

You ask a question, I said, to which a reply can only be given in a parable.

Yes, Socrates; and that is a way of speaking to which you are not at all accustomed, I suppose.

I perceive, I said, that you are vastly amused at having plunged me into such a hopeless discussion; but now hear the parable, and then you will be still more amused at the meagreness of my imagination: for the manner in which the best men are treated in their own States is so grievous that no single thing on earth is comparable to it; and therefore, if I am to plead their cause, I must have recourse to fiction, and put together a figure made up of many things, like the fabulous unions of goats and stags which are found in pictures. **Imagine then a fleet or a ship** in which there is a captain who is taller and stronger than any of the crew, but he is a little deaf and has a similar infirmity in sight, and his knowledge of navigation is not much better. The sailors are quarrelling with one another about the steering --every one is of opinion that he has a right to steer, though he has never learned the art of navigation and cannot tell who taught him or when he learned, and will further assert that it cannot be taught, and they are ready to cut in pieces any one who says the contrary. They throng about the captain, begging and praying him to commit the helm to them; and if at any time they do not prevail, but others are preferred to them, they kill the others or throw them overboard, and having first chained up the noble captain's senses with drink or some narcotic drug, they mutiny and take possession of the ship and make free with the stores; thus, eating and drinking, they proceed on their voyage in such a manner as might be expected of them. Him who is their partisan and cleverly aids them in their plot for getting the ship out of the captain's hands into their own whether by force or persuasion, they compliment with the name of sailor, pilot, able seaman, and abuse the other sort of man, whom they call a good-for-nothing; but that the true pilot must pay attention to the year and seasons and sky and stars and winds, and whatever else belongs to his art, if he intends to be really qualified for the command of a ship, and that he must and will be the steerer, whether other people like or not-the possibility of this union of authority with the steerer's art has never seriously entered into their thoughts or been made part of their calling. Now in vessels which are in a state of mutiny and by sailors who are mutineers, how will the true pilot be regarded? Will he not be called by them a prater, a star-gazer, a good-for-nothing?

Of course, said Adeimantus.

Then you will hardly need, I said, to hear the interpretation of the figure, which describes the true philosopher in his relation to the State; for you understand already.

Certainly.

Then suppose you now take this parable to the gentleman who is surprised at finding that philosophers have no honour in their cities; explain it to him and try to convince him that their having honour would be far more extraordinary.

I will.

Say to him, that, in deeming the best votaries of philosophy to be useless to the rest of the world, he is right; but also tell him to attribute their uselessness to the fault of those who will not use them, and not to themselves. The pilot should not humbly beg the sailors to be commanded by him --that is not the order of nature; neither are 'the wise to go to the doors of the rich' --the ingenious author of this saying told a lie --but the truth is, that, when a man is ill, whether he be rich or poor, to the physician he must go, and he who wants to be governed, to him who is able to govern. **The ruler who is good for anything ought not to beg his subjects to be ruled by him**; although the present

governors of mankind are of a different stamp; they may be justly compared to the mutinous sailors, and the **true helmsmen to those who are called by them good-for-nothings and star-gazers.**

Precisely so, he said.

For these reasons, and among men like these, philosophy, the noblest pursuit of all, is not likely to be much esteemed by those of the opposite faction; not that the greatest and most lasting injury is done to her by her opponents, but by her own professing followers, the same of whom you suppose the accuser to say, that the greater number of them are arrant rogues, and the best are useless; in which opinion I agreed.

Yes.

And the reason why the good are useless has now been explained?

True.

Then shall we proceed to show that the corruption of the majority is also unavoidable, and that this is not to be laid to the charge of philosophy any more than the other?

By all means.

And let us ask and answer in turn, first going back to the description of the gentle and noble nature. Truth, as you will remember, was his leader, whom he followed always and in all things; failing in this, he was an impostor, and had no part or lot in true philosophy.

Yes, that was said.

Well, and is not this one quality, to mention no others, greatly at variance with present notions of him?

Certainly, he said.

And have we not a right to say in his defence, that the true lover of knowledge is always striving after being --that is his nature; he will not rest in the multiplicity of individuals which is an appearance only, but will go on --the keen edge will not be blunted, nor the force of his desire abate until he have attained the knowledge of the true nature of every essence by a sympathetic and kindred power in the soul, and by that power drawing near and mingling and becoming incorporate with very being, having begotten mind and truth, he will have knowledge and will live and grow truly, and then, and not till then, will he cease from his travail.

Nothing, he said, can be more just than such a description of him.

And will the love of a lie be any part of a philosopher's nature? Will he not utterly hate a lie?

He will.

And when truth is the captain, we cannot suspect any evil of the band which he leads?"
