



Introduction

So I have to take on the Modern Historians - those who have gone back to examine these detailed records as well. They each have their own style and biases (as do we all).

The next 500 years sees Scottish, English, Irish, French and German scientists, thinkers, philosophers, writers, dramatists, artists, explorers, poets, etc - authentically explore, debate, argue, disagree and discover a prolific amount about the human condition.

Carrying ideas forward in books - Librarians and historians.

Ideas which had made their way to Paris and Oxford (700s onwards) from Rome, Greece, Egypt, Levant, China and Persia - continued to spread and to be saved from destruction by librarians, scribes, historians. Although you could still see the history of the Romans in buildings and roads - you could read their ideas as well. When the Ottomans sacked Constantinople - Sack of Constantinople - War[1204] Month[4] (Lat/Long 28.9767, 41.01657)

Rome libraries were important since the vestal virgins. The library at Venice became famous - people donated their books to libraries. These records had come from other places too - Alexandria, Levant. The Barbarians and Binary zealots always destroy libraries and history as if to erase human memory and wipe the slate clean for their new version of History - the new caliphate - the new dogma - the new truth - Year 0 starts again.

Hundreds of years of intense debate spread to other places - people from different places could debate the same written works, you could read the works of **Peter Lombard** [1096 to 1160] (the sentences) in Paris, Oxford or Rome and present your ideas in writing for other people to examine and test.

With the overthrow of independence fell the barriers of all exclusive nationalities : the nations were conquered — they were overwhelmed together ; but by that very act were they blended and united ; for, as the limits of the empire were held to comprise the whole earth, so did its subjects learn to consider themselves as one people. From this moment the human family began to acquire the consciousness of its universal brotherhood."

Philoponus' early writings are based on lectures given by Ammonius, but gradually he established his own independent thinking in his commentaries and critiques of Aristotle's On the Soul and Physics. In the latter work Philoponus became one of the earliest thinkers to reject Aristotle's dynamics and propose the "**theory of impetus**":[4] i.e., an object moves and continues to move because of an energy imparted in it by the mover and ceases the movement when that energy is exhausted. This insightful theory was the first step towards the concept of inertia in modern physics, although Philoponus' theory was largely ignored at the time because he **was too radical in his rejection of Aristotle.**

But this [view of Aristotle] is completely erroneous, and our view may be completely corroborated by actual observation more effectively than by any sort of verbal argument. For if you let fall from the same height two weights, one many times heavier than the other you will see that the ratio of the times required for the motion does not depend [solely] on the weights, but that the difference in time is very small. ... — John Philoponus' refutation of the Aristotelian claim that the elapsed time for a falling body is inversely proportional to its weight

Yet **without Aristotle's record to argue with and dispute** John might not have discovered his own new view?

A renowned teacher, his works were much collected and frequently republished across Europe. His "sane conservatism" and his sceptical, logical approach to the study of texts such as Aristotle or the Bible were less prized in the subsequent age of humanism, when a more committed and linguistic/literary approach prevailed.

The list of religious dogma groups keeps growing.

Luther - like all religious zealots - was just as intolerant of debate and difference as all the other binary tribal zealots. What was heresy to the Pope was equally as heretical to Luther, Calvin, Hus and the rest - the work of "the devil" - binary Good/Bad.

Make no mistake - many of these humans involved in these debates - were the most highly educated and respected members of the community - yet they still struggled to debate things away from binary tribal narratives or statements of "certain good" and "certain bad". In the same way that **Carl Sagan** really does not understand what he is talking about yet he trades on his "wisdom" "education" and "science". The universities then were as corrupt as the universities now who churn out ignorant feminists, blacks, jews, jesuits, christians, muslims and all the other binary tribal types - all reaffirming their beliefs in their own group identity and demonizing and attacking those who are different.

Symbolic Abstractions - Vestal Virgins and Queen Elizabeth

It occurs to me that the deliberate stance of Elizabeth is similar to the roman's idea of the vestal virgins - who were the keepers of the flame and the books of knowledge. Part of the relief and vague **HOPE** felt by the population was due to a difference of abstraction levels (my hypothesis) - a change in ideas - a **sufficient "abstraction layer**" from the prevalent dogma of the time. It was a **suitably vague notion** of the "Vestal virgin" Queen with real power but somehow slightly abstracted from religion and war which dominated the landscape. A real human but operating at a slightly different level of abstraction - less controlled by **religion/dogma** and **war/inheritance/power - and more connected to the general population - or at least they may have seen it that way.**

In contrast we see the Greens/Labour politicians, ABC, Blacks, Women and religious zealots, virtue signalers, and professional corrupt bad actors - <u>HAVE NO CONNECTION WITH PEOPLE AT ALL</u> - other than as tools to be used and disposed of as sacrifices to their OWN INSANE DELUSIONAL GLORY.

History - Weaving Facts with Narratives and Opinions

To read history is to see the biases of those who write the historical narratives. **Mandell Creighton** I see now as diligent and authentic but lacking in insight - although his observation of the impacts of the **Dissolution of the monasteries** <u>https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Dissolution of the monasteries</u> is worth noting as an example of unintended consequences and "oops" kind of moment in human history. The Church owned lands and also provided succor and support for many in the community - sick, orphans, poor, old, etc. So when the lands were forcibly taken and the buildings destroyed - there was enormous social upheaval that no-one had planned for. Who was going to look after these people now? Hence we see many documented uprisings and "peasants wars" but I can imagine there were many more undocumented stories of disruption.

Mandell Creighton saw some things but not others - like the corruptions of the church and the extremist violence which dominated the world in religions' name.

I have not yet read **Leopold von Ranke** in depth but he too can weave the human narrative of human interaction - the sequence of events between humans - which requires great level of detailed research and investigation and simple plain facts, dates, people, time and place.

It would take a lifetime to explore the written history in depth so I must dive in from time to time and abstract out from those who have done the detailed work - while also recognizing the need to have the detail and historical records to rely on.

While I am aware of individual humans and their stories - the **story of humans in general** is a **different idea** - hence the term "Humanities" which was developed in universities around the world and is now being defunded and dropped as the religious fanatics, tribal extremists, Greens/Labour types, women, blacks and **tribal activists take over the schools and universities**.

The Three Cornered Debate - with a Binary Overlay

The binary tribal thinking which dominates the world now is the same as the binary tribal thinking in history. Few people can think outside the binary or excel at level 3 and higher cognition levels. Yet something was becoming demonstrably more obvious from the 1300s onwards and was accelerating more rapidly and more widely due to the rapid growth of books and printing in the 1400s. New things were emerging and people were being **woken up from a slumber of hypnotic habit** and **constant binary tribal warfare** to something else.

Families were becoming more intertwined - the Rule of Family inheritance was one law that Families and Rulers relied on to keep the peace and this was consistent across cultures, place and time. **Transition of Power - managing change** - some lessons had been learned from too many bloody tribal warfares and revolutions.


Ideas were spreading and the dogma was no longer totally controlled in Europe by one central authority. Muslim dominated countries (Ottoman Empire), China, Americas (Spanish religious Zealots), Africa - were still mainly dogma controlled or fully tribal - although India was still in the grip of Muslim repression and Mongol invasion - there were pockets of difference along the western coast of India and the mountains. India also had religious variation and powerful city states which made its development more complicated than simple religious dogma and tribes. The Portuguese and other Traders were in contact with South East Asia, Indonesia and Pacific islands. Burma and Thailand were connected in one Empire - First Toungoo Empire https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/First_Toungoo_Empire. Russia was dominated by tribal and religious

dogma and the Mongol horde was dwindling in power.

My hypothesis is that **three mains sets of ideas** were **starting to be noticed** in Europe - England, Scotland, Flanders, Germany, France, Austria and also spreading into Spain, Portugal, Italy, Bohemia. The south Eastern areas (Croatia, Greece, Macedonia and other historical buffer zones (Poland, Bulgaria, Romania, Hungary, Georgia, Armenia) were still dominated by war with the Ottomans, religion and Tribes. The Binary Good/Bad **Extremist overlay** was switching more rapidly and becoming more **difficult to define** in **absolutely certain** ways. Difference, tolerance and plurality were being noticed.

The first printing of the Bible by Johannes Gutenberg [1406 to 1468] was (eventually) celebrated and the Church noticed Arnold Pannartz and Konrad Sweynheim at the Benedictine abbey of Subiaco (around 1465) <u>https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Arnold_Pannartz_and_Konrad_Sweynheim</u> printing Cicero's Letters and other documents - including the bible - but not long after that it became more dangerous. Aldus Manutius [1452 to 1515] <u>https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Aldus_Manutius</u> "founded the Aldine Press. Manutius devoted the later part of his life to publishing and disseminating rare texts. His interest in and preservation of Greek manuscripts mark him as an innovative publisher of his age dedicated to the editions he produced. His enchiridia, small portable books, revolutionized personal reading and are the predecessor of the modern paperback.

Manutius wanted to produce Greek texts for his readers because he believed that works by Aristotle or Aristophanes in their original Greek form were pure and unadulterated by translation. Before Manutius, publishers rarely printed volumes in Greek, mainly due to the complexity of providing a standardized Greek typeface. Manutius published rare manuscripts in their original Greek and Latin forms. He commissioned the creation of typefaces in Greek and Latin resembling the humanist handwriting of his time; typefaces that are the first known precursor of italic type. As the Aldine Press grew in popularity, Manutius's innovations were quickly copied across Italy despite his efforts to prevent the piracy of Aldine editions."

Printing the Bible (the Dogma) in your own local language instead of the Latin approved text became a threat to the Authoritarianism of the church and bible printers could be judged - by the pope - as heretics and excommunicated and/or executed. Henry VIII of England authorized the printing of the Bible https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Great_Bible Great Bible of 1539 which was then replaced by a later more authoritative Bible, https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Geneva_Bible Geneva Bible of 1560 by https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Rowland_Hill_(MP) Sir Rowland Hill of Soulton [1495 to 1561]

Printers, in general, were at risk of **Blasphemy** for daring to question or offend a religion or **Heresy** for everything they printed because it threatened the approved dogma or proscribed behaviours and

thinking of the time. Book fairs spread books widely through the central trading corridor between Lyon and Flanders and to other places nearby. The Trade in books became the same as the trade in other goods via the growing trade routes around the world.

The rites and practices of the churches and the priests **AND the people** were proscribed in law. Not only did the priests have laws of behaviour thrust upon them - but the population was **required to follow the same strict Laws and Customs** - Sing the "right" words

https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Book of Common Prayer (1549), attend the Prayers events, read from the proscribed Books, etc. If you deviated from the **behaviours proscribed by law** - then you were a heretic and the Mob type responses we see now "take the knee" "respect my Authority" were enforced not only by the designated dogma authority figures but also the **local zealots** and **trouble makers** looking for **revenge, rewards** or **money** by "dobbing in" the heretic to the "**Dogma Police**" (Universities, Schools, ABC, Guardian types - now Canberra courts, etc). Accusing people of "heresey" or being possessed by the "devil" because they behaved differently to the "group" (in a non religiously dogmatically defied way - Totalitarian) became a source for many witch trials.

Individual's beliefs varied - and this was now on much clearer display between the church "leaders" and theologians. Debates were no longer behind closed doors in "Diets" - but on display in millions of books with thinkers actively disagreeing with each other in writing. Education was spreading and there were more literate and educated people - noticing that debate and disagreement about ideas was common place - EVEN THOSE MOST EDUCATED at universities - still disagreed with each other about things. The individuals were starting to see themselves as individuals with their own ideas, thoughts and choices and less dominated by the tribal chants and "certain" dogma. This was happening in places like Flanders, Scotland and England - especially because of general shared wealth, education, trade and general well being (although still ravaged by wars, plagues, famines and sickness). To some extent pockets of individual thought had emerged at various times and places throughout history - but the record is unclear. After the 1400s we can see more examples.

The age of Elizabeth by Creighton, M. (Mandell), 1843-1901

Henry's plan was to **maintain the Church discipline** and doctrines unchanged, but to maintain them without the authority of the Pope. As time went on it became clear that this was impossible. The 'men of the new learning' continued to apply to religious matters the **tests of reason, or of primitive custom**, and **much of the existing religious system was beginning to crumble away before them**. Many, on seeing this, became alarmed, and asked themselves the question — Where is this to stop ?

The Binary overlay of Good/Bad - used by the church to assert their control, tyrannical power and control - was more on display as the zealots became ever more binary certain and violent (witch trials, heretics, etc) - and a few (a handful of notable humans) of the non-binary thinkers were starting to question the coherence of constant binary judgement over complex matters and moving towards tolerance - of groups - rather than dogmatic certainty and death.

Some religious groups became authorized and others were considered heretics.

The Jesuits "I'm a professor at a university, don't you know" (take the knee - blacks, women, idiots, extremists, black women "professors") - true believers and other binary extremists zealots - then judged other people for their choices, ideas and beliefs and killed them or demanded they "repent".

Mass migrations of other "belief groups" happened as each "belief" group **stayed in enclaves of their own groupthink**. (Jews, Waldensians, Hussites, Christians, Muslims, etc). **This was all they could manage as an idea of "diversity"** i.e. diversity of **groups** became **tolerance** - but still the individual was demonized and burned at the stake. The binary extremists do not understand plurality - they use words like "Equality" "Diversity" - of **defined groups** under the **dogma we (us/them) control**.
