Some have observed this group behaviour and invented a word to describe it as Allocentrism https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Allocentrism is a collectivistic personality attribute whereby people center their attention and actions on other people rather than" (BINARY) "themselves.[1][2] It is a psychological dimension which corresponds to the general cultural dimension of collectivism ... Subjective well-being (SWB) is term psychological researchers have used when studying happiness[45] Amount of social support allocentrics in collectivist countries received seemed to be related to their well-being with higher support indicative of higher levels of well-being and lower support with lower well-being.[46] North Americans whose lifestyles are more allocentric tend to have higher subjective well-being than those whose life styles are idiocentric. In addition, allocentrics' evaluation of their in-group in addition to how they perceive others view their group is positively related to higher subjective well-being.[47] Allocentrism had a greater effect on the SWB of African Americans than on Euro-Americans. Furthermore, idiocentrism was more negatively related to SWB for Euro-Americans than it was for African Americans... Allocentrism is related to the Big Five personality traits. It is negatively correlated to Openness to experience and positively correlated with Agreeableness and Conscientiousness (Triandis, 2001). Ethnocentricism Allocentrics tend to be more ethnocentric in terms of showing more negative attitudes towards people who are not in their group and more positive attitudes to those in their own group. People who are in allocentrics' in-group are considered much closer than out-group members who are put at a much larger social distance.[49] Allocentrics tend to minimize with-in group differences while preferring equal outcomes in social dilemmas.

These studies emerged in the 1930s - probably as a result people trying to explore the rampant tribalism and horrors of world war 2. Nazis had good "feelings about themselves" The SWB "Subjective well-being" of Mulsims, Nazis, feminists and self righteous mobs is very high - much higher than the average. Hence the Smug laughing smiling cheering and clapping - stoking up their "happiness" and "doing good" with Allocentrism - their in-group wages war with "outsiders".

These tribal fuckwits say "I hope we can get another Barnaby Joyce moment" and "I feel good about jihad" and "We are good people on the right side of history"

It is a matter of fact that there are more highly educated advanced mathematical and clever men throughout world history than women or black triabalists - not because of discrimination, not because of oppression, not because of theft or white domination - but because on average - slightly higher percentages of many characteristic traits (genetics) and other complex things of people allow more exceptional people to develop. The European style western culture tends to be more explorative, less tribal or binary. The Edict of Expulsion was a royal decree issued by Edward I on 18 July 1290 expelling all Jews from the Kingdom of England, the first time a European state is known to have permanently banned their presence.... The first Jewish communities are recorded in England after 1066.[1] Jews were viewed as the direct jurisdiction and property of the king,[2] making them subject to the whims of the king, who could tax or imprison them as he wished, without reference to anyone else.[3][b] A very small number of Jews were wealthy, as they were allowed to lend money at interest, while the Church forbade Christians from doing so, as this constituted the sin of usury.[4] As capital was in short supply and necessary for development, Jewish loans played an important economic role in England's development.[5]

Christians are "Holier than thou" while Jews who lend money are "sinners". But of course the Ottomans, Muslims and Barbarian hordes owned everyone's life, possessions, gold, land, food everything belonged to the Tribal leaders - humans existed only to serve the Muslims and other Barbarian and Tribal psychopaths (Greens/Labour) needs - slaves to the rulers. Slavery is still considered "Natural" in many places in the world and throughout history.

The Holy See had placed restrictions on Jews from mixing with Christians, and mandated the wearing of distinctive clothing such as tabula, or Jewish badges, at the Fourth Lateran Council in 1215.[6] They were adopted in England at the Synod of Oxford in 1222. Church leaders made the first allegations of ritual child sacrifice, such as crucifixions at Easter in mockery of Christ, and began to link these with ideas of conspiracy and occult practices. King Henry III backed allegations made against Jews of Lincoln after the death of a boy Hugh, soon known as Little Saint Hugh.[7] Such stories coincided with the rise of hostility within the Church to the Jews.

Discontent was further fuelled as the Crown destabilised the loans and debt market. Loans were typically secured through bonds entitling the lender to the debtor's land holdings. Jews were overtaxed, forcing them to sell their debt bonds at cut down prices to raise cash quickly. The cut price bonds would be bought by rich courtiers, who could then call in the loans and demand the lands that had secured the loans. This caused the transfer of the land wealth of indebted knights and others especially from the 1240s onwards, as the taxation placed on the Jews became unsustainably high. [8] Leaders like Simon de Montfort then used anger at the dispossession of middle ranking landowners to fuel antisemitic violence, at London (where 500 Jews died), Worcester, Canterbury, and many other towns. [9] In the 1270s and 80s, Queen Eleanor amassed vast lands and properties through this process, causing widespread resentment and conflict with the church, who viewed her acquisitions as profiting from usury. [10] By 1275, as the result of punitive taxation, the crown had eroded the Jewish community's wealth to the extent that taxes produced little return

Notice how stealing from Jews was NOT considered a sin?????

Introduction

The Ottomans, Muslims and Khans will still threatening much of the world and places like Romania and the Balkans - Bulgaria, Serbia, Croatia - were fully occupied protecting them selves - and to a large extent - the rest of Europe - from the continued Barbarian assaults. Without this protection I doubt that Parts of Northern Europe would have been able to develop as much as they did.

I have nearly completed examining the lives of individuals born in the 1500s and what I realize is that there is too many for me to list. It is not that human individuals are not all important in some way - but these stand-out individuals are everywhere in northern Europe in the 1500s. Less tribal and more individualistic working with other talented individuals. For every single stand-out name there are hundreds of other associated people - all with some great merit and skill. For example https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Marin Mersenne Marin Mersenne living mainly in Paris was a pivotal centre for an explosion of French, Italian, Ducth and English talent which has given the world some of the most impressive individual humans in record history in maths, philosophy, astronomy, science and political theory. "In 1635 he set up the informal Académie Parisienne (Academia Parisiensis), which had nearly 140 correspondents, including astronomers and philosophers as well as mathematicians, and was the precursor of the <u>Académie des sciences</u> established by <u>Jean-Baptiste</u> Colbert in 1666. [a] He was not afraid to cause disputes among his learned friends in order to compare their views, notable among which were disputes between Descartes, Pierre de Fermat, and Jean de Beaugrand. [6] Peter L. Bernstein, in his book Against the Gods: The Remarkable Story of Risk, wrote, "The Académie des Sciences in Paris and the Royal Society in London, which were founded about twenty years after Mersenne's death, were direct descendants of Mersenne's activities"

While we had cohorts of these talented men in guilds and trade organizations - some of that was around protecting skills and knowledge but also pay and conditions in a kind of trade union way - we also see many other groups form where people learned from men of the past and passed on skills and **experimented** and **explored** as they learned.

Schools for poets and singers were growing https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Meistersinger A

Meistersinger (German for "master singer") was a member of a German guild for lyric poetry, composition and unaccompanied art song of the 14th, 15th and 16th centuries. The Meistersingers were drawn from middle class males for the most part.

Choirs and Music were growing everywhere. Rich cities like Venice were become centers for music and art. https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Claudio Monteverdi Claudio Giovanni Antonio Monteverdi [n 1] (baptized 15 May 1567 – 29 November 1643) was an Italian composer, choirmaster and string player. A composer of both secular and sacred music, and a pioneer in the development of opera, he is considered a crucial transitional figure between the Renaissance and Baroque periods of music history

Livery companies of England continued to develop https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Livery company but also government type bodies who perform some function on behalf of the royalty but more often part of the state organization e.g. https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/College of Arms

But we also see the Rose Cross https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Rosicrucianism Rosicrucianism start to develop at the end of the 1500s - mainly centered around ideals of doing good deeds "Gratis" for free, advancing learning using the Greek knowledge (Aristotle, Plato, etc) and other scientific topics but also some "mystical" (unscientific) ideas which Marin Marsenne argued against. It was still case then (as it is now in Muslim countries and China) that expressing your beliefs about things related to anything but especially "gods of certainty" could end in death and the hands of tribal and religious zealots and other dim-wits - so it is no wonder that some of these societies became protective and secretive. This is a different approach to debating the topics directly with the tribal mobs (See the behaviour of

Greens/Labour - Penny Wong, Tanya Plibersek, Claire O'Neil, Anthony Albanese, Chris Bowen, etc - all vitriol, personal attack, calling out the Mob, corruption, lies, etc) - instead hoping to provide education and hope for those not subject to binary tribal responses, allowing them to slowly overcome the rampant violence, corruption and ignorance we see around us everywhere today. (Blacks, Women (on average- tribal/binary), Religious Zealots (Muslims, etc) and weak minded men - tribal virtue signalers "feeling good")

Exceptional individuals were valued in the 1500s. All individuals were valued for the work they did. Queen Elizabeth I of England reigned from 1558 to 1603 in a time of Non-Catholic religious zealotry rule surrounded by young and old men - some of the most talented and explorative men the world has ever seen. Talented individuals were working together and aiding each other in large projects. Every English ship which sailed had large numbers of talented people involved - experts in ship building and design, navigation, tool making, record keeping, astronomical observation, food preparation, planning, diplomacy, logistics, languages, maths, cartography, depth sounding, sailmaking, agriculture, botany, stone masonry - you name it - there were skilled people there. There were also nobles who had sponsored the journeys. Not all explorations were successful but people learned from their mistakes.

Each trip was a learning and discovery trip and the Dutch and the English were at war with the religious Zealots - Spain and Muslims on the high seas across the world. The Dutch were in the golden age of cartography and the Muscovy Company (1555), East India Company (1600) and the Dutch East India Company (1602) were only some of the trading companies set up to explore the world and break the domination of trade by the Portuguese, Spanish (allegiances to Genoa), Ottomans (with allegiances with Venice) and Muslim-Asian trade networks. Although by middle to late 1500s Genoa was losing its power as a merchant sailing fleet and gaining power as Bankers, Financers and Slave dealers. https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Republic_of_Genoa_The Spanish, with their intramural allies, the "old nobility" entrenched in the mountain fastnesses behind Genoa, captured the city on May 30, 1522, and subjected the city to a pillage. When the admiral Andrea Doria of the powerful Doria family allied with the Emperor Charles V to oust the French and restore Genoa's independence, a renewed prospect opened: 1528 marks the first loan from Genoese banks to Charles.[34]

Under the ensuing economic recovery, many aristocratic Genoese families, such as the Balbi, Doria, Grimaldi, Pallavicini, and Serra, amassed tremendous fortunes. According to Felipe Fernandez-Armesto and others, the practices Genoa developed in the Mediterranean (such as chattel slavery) were crucial in the exploration and exploitation of the New World Thereafter, Genoa underwent something of a revival as a junior associate of the Spanish Empire, with Genoese bankers, in particular, financing many of the Spanish crown's foreign endeavors from their counting houses in Seville. Fernand Braudel has even called the period 1557 to 1627 the "age of the Genoese", "of a rule that was so discreet and sophisticated that historians for a long time failed to notice it".

From about **1520 the Genoese controlled the port of Panama**, the first port on the Pacific, founded by the conquest of the Americas. The Genoese obtained a concession to exploit the port mainly for the slave trade of the new world on the Pacific, until the destruction of the primeval city in 1671

Dutch and English people cooperated especially against the Spanish and muslims.

Apart from https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Zheng_He **Zheng He** (1371 to 1433) there is not much evidence of regular Chinese trade ships outside of the general area of China and the Philippines, Malaysia (Malacca) and Indonesia (Acheh) and nearby islands.

Intellectuals were cooperating across Europe. Universities and libraries were growing and people exchanged ideas and learned things specifically outside of the religious studies and other Tribal education which had dominated the world for centuries. Even places like Italy were struggling to escape tribal religious extremism but people like https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Federico Cesi

Federico Angelo Cesi (1585 to 1630) was inviting talented individuals to investigate all of the Natural Sciences in Accademia dei Lincei (1603) https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Accademia dei Lincei ("Membership was banned to monks. Members were ordered to "penetrate into the interior of things in order to know the causes and operations of nature, as it is said the lynx does, which sees not only what is outside, but what is hidden within.") - people came from all of Europe - including Galileo Galilei.

Explorations of the mind were occurring in all forms - science, botany, astronomy, drama, poetry, education, printing, books, maps, maritime technology, diplomacy, spying (intelligence - codes), negotiation, law, governance. People were inventing things - the flush toilet was invented and 3 stage rockets. The Intellectual movements in England, Scotland, Denmark, Northern Europe (Belgium, Netherlands) were in stark contrast to education in the religiously dominated world in the rest of Europe (Catholic/Muslim/Other), Africa (Muslim/Tribal) Asia (Muslim/Taoism/Other), India (Muslim/Hindu/Jainism/Other) - while general Tribalism was widespread around the world.

What I failed to first notice was that not only were BOOKS spreading rapidly, but also the MAIL SYSTEM was growing. Travel all over Europe and sailing the world was possible and becoming more frequent but Marin Mersenne was able to debate ideas (continuing the debate after initial personal interaction) - correspond - with people all over Europe. This was not only for diplomatic messages but EVERYTHING could be debated by mail. https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Mail in 1505, Holy Roman Emperor Maximilian I established a postal system in the Empire, appointing Franz von Taxis to run it. This system, originally the Kaiserliche Reichspost, is often considered the first modern postal service in the world, which initiated a revolution in communication in Europe. [42][43][44] The system combined contemporary technical and organization means to create a stable transcontinental service which was also the first to offer (fee-based) public access. [45][46][47][48]

The Thurn und **Taxis family**, then known as Tassis, had operated postal services between Italian city-states from **1290 onward**.

Postmaster Anselm Franz, 2nd Prince of Thurn and Taxis (1681–1739) still today part of the logo of the Whitepages in many countries

For 500 years the postal business based in Brussels and in Frankfurt was passed from one generation to another. Following the abolition of the Empire in 1806, the Thurn-und-Taxis Post system continued as a private organization into the postage stamp era before being absorbed into the postal system of the new German Empire after 1871

The Tasso/Tassis/Taxis family originated in the Italian Alps in Camerata Cornello Lat/Long(45.89,9.65)



A Network of Principles, A Principle of Networks

Communication, Cooperation and **Trust** were essential to the exchange of ideas between humans - especially when it came to Books, Letters and the **Mail service**. What we now take for granted was developed over many thousands of years and became more of a public service over a hundred years in the 1500s (part of a "commonwealth" idea).



The Principle of trusted and authentic communication grew in importance.

Religion, Diplomacy, Trade, universities, - but then all networks started to develop. Communication grew as a business and importance.

For thousands of years - Emperors, Mongols Khans, Sultans - established their own communication networks - and horse riders would ride all die until they dropped dead from exhaustion. But the private family companies (trusted, experience, capable and reliable) - not only the regular merchant trader ships - but **professional couriers** - deliverers of messages and information - not only "Papal Bulls" but **all communication**.

From 1300s onwards the **Papal communication systems** were in part maintained by a large trusted family - The**Tasso/Tassis/Taxis** family originated in the Italian Alps in **Camerata Cornello** Lat/Long(45.89,9.65)

Henry the Eighth of England had established a Job of Master of Posts in 1516.

https://www.britannica.com/topic/postal-system/History#ref367074 In France, Louis XI set up a Royal Postal Service in 1477 employing 230 mounted couriers. In England, a Master of the Posts was appointed by Henry VIII in 1516 to maintain a regular postal service along the main roads radiating from London. Neither of these systems was comprehensive, nor were they intended to serve the public. The security and regularity of the service along certain routes, however, inevitably resulted in an increasing amount of unofficial correspondence being carried. After initial attempts to prevent this practice in France, its fiscal advantages were realized, and the carrying of private mails was legalized about 1600. The basis of a real public service was not created until 1627, when fees and timetables were fixed and post offices established in the larger cities. In Britain, a separate public service was set up in 1635 by a royal proclamation "for the settling of the letter-office of England and Scotland." Thomas Witherings, a London merchant, was given the task of organizing regular services to run by day and night along the great post roads.

Perspectives, they exist. Learning perspectives is possible. Perspectives help examine things. Humans - they can learn from perspectives.


Proud Individual Accomplishment is not the Same as Smug Tribal Virtue Signaling

Most people have no idea of what I have accomplished individually. I work, think and explore and feel embarrassed by tribal responses of anyone telling me I am doing a "Good" job and care less if they say I am doing a "Bad job" (it is, **after all**, my own work not piece work for a tyrannical employer). I am not doing a "Good" job - I am being me - an individual and exploring the things I

choose to explore. These feelings of exploring individually and taking the knee to the Mob of "expectations" are at **extreme ends of a feelings spectrum for me**. I Shun the Mob and tribal groupthink wherever I see them and do not wish to kowtow and be part of the tribal mobs.

Accomplished individuals have infectious qualities about them. Other individuals want to be around them, learn, explore and become individuals themselves. As a group of individuals they feed off the discoveries, mistakes and learning from each other - they shun grand gestures and work hard on the issues they are grappling with regardless of tribal and Mob opinion - they seek to **make sense of things** and be able to explain it to others.

Evolutionary responses we have are difficult to understand. Most people have no real idea of what they are feeling or why. But on the plurality model we can explore the spread of emotions - some concerned with groups and tribalism and some more concerned with individual learning and development (not for self and not for others) - i.e. being **driven to learn and explore** is not the same emotional response has having to attend schooling for the sake of obedience to tradition and etiquette. I originally worked through the general emotional ranges in humans in **15 Humanism** – **Corruption – Nation Choice – Virtue, Version 1, date 03/04/2020** https://humanistman.com/wpcontent/uploads/2020/04/15-Humanism-Corruption-Nation-Choice-Virtue.pdf . in the following diagram I have extracted some the key emotional drivers and responses and mapped them to the plurality curve to highlight the spread and show that Individual self-motivation has emotions purely for the individual while other emotional responses are more connected to the group and things like "Virtue Signaling" and Moral Grandstanding are very strong tribal responses.



We see these groups of individuals sometimes in history - highly self-critical, hard working, conscientious, open to new ideas, not smug or seeking to be stroked or rewarded, critically examining everything, testing, exploring, playing, having fun and casting their nets wide to examine and experience things. Many of these networks of accomplished individuals were growing and developing in England and other parts of Europe in the 1500s.

As Francis Bacon observed - even individual learning needs to have some widely recognized award - a **certificate** of achievement or some "**feathers of ostentation**"

Tycho Brahe and Marin Mersenne had huge personal influence on many others. Many teachers at universities around Europe influenced many others - who then went on to teach others. Vast networks of ideas exploded and spread quickly around astronomy, Maps, science, engineering, architecture, art, botany, medicine, metallurgy, printing, sailing, canals, city design, house design - exploration, investigation, hypothesis, testing and investigating.

An Aside: I remember as an 8 year old boy at school finally understanding mental arithmetic and especially the two times table. What started as repetition out loud in the class room became practiced silently in my head. I rapidly repeated the tables over and over in my head and practiced to see how high I could go in my head. The fastest and quickest was the two times table. This gave me an overwhelming sense of accomplishment and from then on at school I was an outsider to the groups. Those who always wanted to form groups practiced forming groups. I spent most of my time in special classes or reading by my self. I spent years reading all the books - including the dictionary - in the school library rather than forming into social groups.

This feeling of individual achievement is not the same as GROUP feelings of virtue signaling. I DO NOT NEED anyone to recognize or cheer, clap and reward me for anything I have done. I hold my own sense of achievement within myself. This is very confronting to smug idiot tribal mobs - they instantly want to attack the individual especially any-one claiming to be "special" and point out their failures as human beings so the idiot MOB can say to each other "SEE HOW OUR MOB IS BETTER THAN CLEVER INDIVIDUALS". René Descartes https://www.worldhistory.org/Rene Descartes/Descartes/ He was at one of the most renowned schools in Europe but became filled with doubt and with a failed attempt to instruct himself, he soon discovered what he considered to be his own ignorance. Heavily influenced by the ideas of both Galileo (1564-1642) and Copernicus (1473-1543) and their heliocentric view of the universe where the sun, not the earth, was the center of the solar system, Descartes embarked on a long road that would change the very nature of philosophy for generations to come.

We are in a world dominated by Smug, Self-aggrandizing, Tribal, Binary, ignorant people who in a **Fat, Dumb and Lazy** way - have **achieved nothing in life** considered special and **never will** - yet constantly demean those who are trying or might succeed and they also DEMAND EQUAL PAY for being **determinedly TRIBAL IDIOTS.**

The reasons Muslims do not want women to go to schools and universities are the same reason the Churches were concerned about the growth of non religious universities in the 1500s. It is the same reason that Australian schools are taught tribalism and to hate men and Boys and Celebrate

The Trusted respected capable individual man working with other trusted capable authentic fair dealing men on difficult and complicated tasks. Not narcissists. Not Tribalists. Archimedes Power Law Kepler and Calculus


Archimedes's Eureka moment is linked with Pythagoras (asserted right angle), the Power law - **Exponentiation**, infinite spatial dimensions (pi), calculus - differentiation, integration.

All based on the asserted Pythagoras right angle triangle, the power law and Euclid. See Integer – Ratio – Power Law – Chaos https://humanistman.com/wp-content/uploads/2020/12/Integer-Ratio-Power-Law-Chaos.pdf The power law (Exponentiation/Logarithm) became not only a descriptive tool for spatial distances but also changes over space and time in infinite multiple dimensions. Flow rates, cyclic rates, Harmonic Frequencies, etc.

Archimedes had found a perfect relationship between the Cone, Sphere and Cylinder spatial volumes of 1,2,3. https://thatsmaths.com/2019/11/28/archimedes-and-the-volume-of-a-sphere/ which interestingly relates the circle and the square (the profile of a cylinder) together. But it also seems to be moving between an integration and differentiating (calculus) type approach as well.

Kepler had also discovered the paths of planets and other bodies were **ellipses**, not perfect circles - which as you can see - can be described on a **Cone** (Cones are perfectly related to Spheres, Cylinders, Circles and Squares spatially).

Calculus https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Calculus Infinitesimal calculus was developed independently in the late 17th century by Isaac Newton and Gottfried Wilhelm Leibniz while described as "change" and "infinitesimals" is really about simple maths and manipulation of the power law as asserted by Pythagoras. Instead of simple squares and roots, the powers con progress infinitely in either direction.

In essence it describes mathematical functions which all have a power law attached to each part of the function and then moves up and down the differentiation and integration techniques. Part of the assumption is that any constant number - really isn't a number or a fixed constant - it has a power attached to it - Exponentiation https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Logarithm The natural logarithm has the number $e \approx 2.718$ as its base; its use is widespread in mathematics and physics, because of its very simple derivative. The binary logarithm uses base 2 and is frequently used in computer science.

Some years after Kepler we see two of the greatest human minds emerge with the same concept around the same time and there were some disputes of Who thought of it first. **Calculus and Infinitesimals**

There are many different ways we might explore this idea. We can have different perspectives. For example does it matter who thought of it first? Does it mean someone spied or stole from someone else? Does it mean that it is possible for people to come up with the same idea?

One thing which occurs to me is given the extremely large number of humans - only a very few have highly developed skills in any area and I find it remarkable that anyone came up with this idea at all. It amazes me that **SO FEW PEOPLE** have the capability to investigate and **INVENT AN IDEA** that's is so advanced and clever and long lasting.

If you sat down millions of people for years to explain the universe - NO-ONE is guaranteed of ever having any idea or developing any reliable, repeatable, testable idea as powerful as calculus and its application to exploring and describing many things in the universe.

In other words - these men - a handful - and their discoveries are EXTREMELY RARE EVENTS and you cannot expect that ANYONE would ever be able to do it again. LET ALONE - MANDATE - that based on tribal characteristics - a human is "an ideas person" or a "thinker". Or to put it another way - if you do not develop your skills , experiences and techniques and struggle with adding and subtracting two numbers (like all the young people who cannot give you the correct change when you use cash to buy things) - then do not expect to be paid the same as someone who is an advanced mathematician.




Binaries mainly see the world as binary comparisons of 4 pairs of things. They do not understand or believe each declared thing is "different' because this requires an understanding of

- Initial self-reference (starting somewhere)
- Recursion (not,not the ability to differentiate and explore meaning)

For binaries - all concepts and languages - sentences and thought are based around rapid switching backwards and forwards between these 4 main pairs of things. They can do very little else - having no understanding of the continuum (zero and infinities) or having the ability to use Fishers 4 box model.

For example commentators on TV like Joe Hildebrand will say things like "They are both as bad as each other" "They are the same" "Party A is better than Party B because..." "The Bad actor was only one individual - he does not represent the group"

Binaries are very limited in their cognitive ability and can only operate at simple binary levels on simple tasks that have been explained to them or follow some set path.

So to be really very specific - Binaries reject the hypothesis that two declared things are not exactly the opposite of each other. They declare any TWO things and then construct a **permanent opposite connection** in a **binary certain** way - War/Peace - Good/Bad - constructing large certain binary hierarchies - ignoring the continuum and struggling to make any other connections except their binary certainties - and then they double down and attack anyone who threatens their mental effort to construct these certain hierarchies. They usually "**play the victim**" and they do this in **a passive aggressive** way. (For more on "hierarchies" of declared things - See nodes, Network architectures, Graph theory, e Euler, etc)

"I think, you think..." (I know what is inside your head and what you are thinking)

First thing to note is the Narcissist. The" I Amness" (yoga) - constant self focus.

Second thing to note is that they think they are thinking, can think and then - not only that - understand what you think. The **Delusion**.

Now let me explain this technique. It is deliberately designed to **distract you** and **put you on the defensive** (Penny Wong - "Remember, I am the victim here"). The general technique is to **say something so absurd that you are distracted**. So, once distracted, you then have to deal with their assertion.



"I was punching him and he had the audacity to punch back" "How dare You!" says that fucking tribal liar Katy Gallagher.



If they "feel" afraid or your "language" might upset them the police and courts will smash your head in. It is not a matter of what you do or have done as a human - it is simply a matter about someone "feels" about you or what they (the declared victim) imagine you "might do or think".

This obsession has caused the deaths of large percentages of humans - especially highly capable individuals - and still does in places like China, Muslim countries, Africa and tribal countries like Australia, New Zealand, UK, USA, Canada and many others.




The Plurality Model techniques explored

I will expand a little more for level 3 thinkers on the plurality model. This will be a **difficult thing for most people to follow** so I will work my way through carefully. We can examine the idea of the Binary Linking tendency a bit further - We all tend to binary thinking because it **takes work to explore** what we are saying and thinking. I have some things which I have developed to help me explore my own thinking and the thinking of others.

- 1. **Duality of Definition and Measurement** You cannot simply assert a thing and then have no supporting definition and some idea of how it is measured because all you get is a meaningless assertion. Meaning , shared understanding and usefulness comes from more work on those **two things. Shared group schemas depend on this**. Or to put it another way mindless loons all nodding and smiling at each other saying "Good" is a base tribal response at the lower end of the evolutionary scale.
- 2. If I accept a duality of measurement and definition I then have end points (Bounds and constraints). At one end is the dual god point of Zero and Null and at the other end point I have infinities. This gives me the ability to place every thing declared and every measurement made in the frame. There is a continuum between end points. Frege declares https://plato.stanford.edu/entries/frege-theorem/#5.1 5.1 Zero is a Natural Number, 5.2 Zero Isn't the Successor of Any Natural Number, 5.3 No Two Natural Numbers Have the Same Successor, 5.4 The Principle of Mathematical Induction, 5.5 Every Natural Number Has a Successor, 5.6 Arithmetic i.e. Zero is a number and it is special.

One idea in logic is to try to be comprehensive and avoid paradoxes - my idea is to know where you paradoxes are - **initial self-reference** and **recursions** and explicitly state them in relation to other things. https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/List_of_paradoxes



3. With the plurality box in place I can then declare ANY THING and place opposite the declare thing it opposite declaration which is **NOT**. So a **Thing** either **IS** or **IS NOT** - **and these are the extreme ends of the plurality curve. To be specific this is the basis of the Russell Paradox - i.e. a binary definition problem of NOT** https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Russell%27s_paradox which I have placed at the unachievable end of a continuum of IS and NOT IS

There is something very important to take notice of this technique. I have made it almost impossible for a declaration to be ABSOLUTELY correct either as the thing declared or the NOT. In other words infinity and null are the bounds and constraints from which we can explore definitions and

measurements. It is generally accepted in all of human development that infinity is unknown and un achievable and absolute null is also unknown and unachievable. This is the working hypothesis of most educated people. Religious zealots instead declare that they know exactly what null means and exactly what infinity means. This certainty helps them overcome their deep anxieties.


4. I use Fishers 4 Box model to help explore the two declared things in a comprehensive way to see a connection of two things makes sense. Working through fishers 4 Box model allows me to check and explore what I am thinking and keeps **reminding me** of the NOT, NOT - the double NOT, NOT which is a recursive infinity. The EXTRA THING to notice is the infinitely recursive double NOT, NOT applies to **any two declared things** - **including** my two original definitions **Definition** and **Measurement**. So this **reminds me of the question of my own model** - if it is not definition and it is not measurement - then what is it? This is a fundamental philosophical frame and argument going back thousands of years - as is the argument with zero, null and infinity. I have to leave this as an open question just in case some thing else turns up.

Lets us now look at the example of looking at comparing two things. We are going to compare two declared things **Red** and **Green**. Now at this point many of you will say but I learned at school that they are all part of the same thing. Apart from the Quantum, Continuum and wave issues - there is still a point of definition - that is, declaring what the word 'Red" means and then there is a second idea of saying "How do I measure Red now that I have defined it?"

This is difficult even for level 3 thinkers **Exploring Plurality Exploring Plurality** Green Red **Not Red Not Green** Red Green **Exploring Plurality** Red **Not Red Exploring Plurality** Green Green Red Not Red Red **Not Red** lot Green **Green Not Gree Not Green** (Not Green) Green **Not Red** Red (Not Red) Red **Not Green** Green

So you can see that Red and Green are two different declared things which are completely different. The FIRST in-between place has become a NORMAL curve instead of a PLURALITY CURVE - because I think it is more normally distributed rather than Pushed into a plurality curve. I tend to use Plurality curves for many things in Humans which tend one way over two compared things rather than tending to binary certain extremes - either Green or Red - nothing in between. Binaries cannot do this and do not understand this technique. Some people will say you are "Comparing Apples with Oranges". In this particular example I am comparing things we use a group word for- the declared is "Colour" (the binaries would make this a fixed hierarchy of listed binary colours)

The other thing to notice is that I can examine every combination of the 4 boxes models as Distribution curves. Any way I choose. For example my comparison of Box 1 with box 4 gives the Following curve.



At one end is the extreme of both Red and Green and at the other end is not Red and not Green. In the middle are things with various amounts of red and green (and their nots). You might say that this does not make any sense to you. I understand that this difficult but it is simply a matter of working through the process and then examining the result. There are things which contain a duality of red/green to a greater or lesser degree.

Just to check you are keeping up - I can declare a things as "Colour" and its "NOT COLOUR" is automatically associated with it at the other end of the plurality curve. I carry that model with me in my head when discussing things people declare.


I want to make this idea very clear. This is exactly the point that many philosophers invent a different system. They believe that Colour is not the SAME as RED - this is the **forms and attributes** argument. They then say that you need to look at these things a different way. So they will argue that comparing Good and Bad is Not the SAME as comparing Red and Green.

I disagree - it is the same process. My process works for any two things declared. I do not have to invent a completely new process which invalidates this. I also think that this process is simple enough to help the binary thinkers escape constant binary switching.

The hint is how much meaning do we need to associate with the comparison? What actions do we take as a result? What do we learn from this comparison process?

For example if you examine the many dystopian novels and group think explorations - you will notice exactly the problem. **TWO ARBITRARY THINGS ARE DECLARED** and then the "God/Rulers" decide which one is preferred over the "other". The basis of tribal responses.

For example one tribal thing could be declared "NECK RINGS" and then other tribe might declare "TATTOOS". If you follow my model on those two declared things you see that it still works - even on the face of it those two things declared and compared have **no meaning to you at all** - somewhere in some tribal universe it is a tribal/binary matter of life or death.



<u>An Aside</u>: You might think that all of this is really simple and straight forward and obvious. You may be unaware of how helpful an insightful it is. One way to provide some context is compare this with the work of some world famous philosophers and mathematicians.

adulatory publicity surrounding the critical positivity ratio concept contributed to a perception of social psychology as a field lacking scientific soundness and rigorous critical thinking. [14][9][15] Sokal later stated, "The main claim made by Fredrickson and Losada is so implausible on its face that some red flags ought to have been raised" (Binary - tribal and incompetent people operate in all professions)

"Happy" is an invented concept - a "god type" word of little meaning. Like the word "Good" it is largely meaningless and unmeasured. These types of words are used by those people who constantly self-stimulate their own personal internal "feelings" and lack the ability to discuss or debate anything (women, blacks, religious zealots, virtue signalers - tribal types on average).

Try using the Australian type expression of "Not Bad". When a golfer hits a golf ball a long distance with great skill and overcomes the odds of getting the ball into the hole and it seems amazing - instead of jumping with joy and kissing each other - the Australians will say "Not Bad".

When a pig (Babe, the film) organizes sheep into a pen - the Farmer will say "That will do, Pig" - as if to say - "Not Bad". That is sufficient. **That is enough**. That is not the "be all and end all". There is more work to be done, there are more things to be discovered - you have got that done now move on to the next challenge - don't stay stuck in your "Glorious Happy Days"

Or you can try to avoid the negative feelings of feeling down all the time or melancholy.




Definition and measurement of things takes work - this upsets fat, dumb and lazy humans.

This ability to shift focus and change perspectives is one of Kepler's greatest achievements. To move from the observer to the thing being observed and then try to imagine what things look like from that perspective is a significant cognitive skill which many humans fail to develop. E.g. He wrote a story about going to the Moon and Imagining what things might look like.

and practice. E.g. Astronauts, Navigators, Aircraft Pilots, Sailors, Map makers, Mathematicians, Astronomers, etc. And also, in later times - science fiction writers.

Being able to **orientate**. Having a **perspective**.

This finding suggests that human spatial navigation strategies are quite flexible, exploit multisensory information, and depend on the particular type of response that is required at the given moment. In contrast to previous desktop experiments asking for a simple homing response that demonstrated a preference for distinct reference frames 17,18,38 the current task showed that the majority of participants preferred an allocentric reference frame. Having to constantly update one's own position as well as the position of other entities in space (landmark, home) likely fosters the use of an allocentric reference frame.

But Kepler had gone further than a simple human task of walking through some objects - he had imagined a solar system of completely abstracted concepts and explored their relations and navigated those relationships through time and space. The relations had been described mathematically - some time later Isaac Newton added the name of the cause of the relationships as "gravity".

But Kepler was not the first to Imagine the universe in a different way.

Perspective is measured in angles of observation - the observer and the thing observed using Pythagoras right angle triangle and all of the maths around that using the Pythagoras power law and Euclid sine, cosine, tangent, etc - combinations of angles and length. But perspective is also about the time dimension - where the stars are in the sky is important but suddenly Kepler puts all things in motion - not only the obvious cycles of the Sun and the Moon - but suddenly everything observable in the universe is in constant related motion with each other. The astronomers, cartographers and sailors - after enormous effort of measurement, note taking and detailed documentation - had charted and documented much of the planet and the locations but also the sky and the position of the stars and planets at different times of the year. With two supernovas observed in the nights sky by Tycho Brahe and then Kepler - along with the comet of 1577 https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Great_Comet_of_1577 - suddenly the sky was filled with moving things - not only the solar system - but everything.

Supernovas are rare events https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/History of supernova observation with only 8 possibly observed in recorded history up to recent times. The most recent supernova to be seen in the Milky Way galaxy was SN 1604, which was observed on October 9, 1604. Several people, including Johannes van Heeck, noted the sudden appearance of this star, but it was Johannes Kepler who became noted for his systematic study of the object itself. 


Then we can zoom in on the map and mark the approximate location of Keplers'House in Linz Lat/Long(48.30584, 14.28519)

Many people were still trying to connect the ideas of the things they saw in the sky and what was happening on Earth around them. Earthquakes, famines, volcanic explosions in local areas or in other places in the world - were being recorded and observed . This relates a history of comets appearing in the sky and being a sign of something important - of forthcoming disaster. But everything in the sky was of great portent. Astrology (soothsayers) were all the rage in the 1500s and many Astronomers were also Astrologers who sold future predictions to the gullible based on the positions of the stars in the sky. Across the world now many countries believe in fate and gods and similar things. was returned to the Papal States, despite the attempts of the young duke, who sought help from the major powers to no avail.[clarification needed].


The **capital was therefore moved to Modena**, which he entered on 30 January 1598. His first years were troublesome: he had to face the quarrels between the **Modenese and Ferrarese nobles who had come with him**, the attempt at independence of Maro Pio of Sassuolo, and a war against Lucca for the possession of Garfagnana.

In a similar way to the Mulsims and Ottomans - the Papal States INHERIT all the belongings of everyone who dies without a proper **Heir**.

So the questions remains - **who re-built Ferrara and when?** Are the following maps accurate? Ferrara is noted as a UNESCO world heritage city today. https://whc.unesco.org/en/list/733/ and was probably reestablished and completely at some time after the earthquake of 1570.

But By 1600 it seems that Ferrara had been completely restored and there are two maps (unsure of source) which seem to be from about 1600 showing a large walled city featuring the same city layouts of the cities in the Netherlands. Between 1614 and 1620, about 400 manuscripts and books were published which discussed the Rosicrucian documents. The peak of the "Rosicrucianism furore" was reached when two mysterious posters appeared on the walls of Paris in 1622 within a few days of each other. The first said "We, the Deputies of the Higher College of the Rose-Croix, do make our stay, visibly and invisibly, in this city (...)", and the second ended with the words "The thoughts attached to the real desire of the seeker will lead us to him and him to us."


