Preamble

If there is no such thing as permanent certainty than what remains?

Most people struggle with the **idea of sustained debates** and constantly look for certainty to "win" the argument in a tribal warfare sense. Chris Bowen will look away and change the subject or leave when he is questioned about anything - he avoids debate and mocks and attacks people who dare to try to engage him with a sustained debate. Most Greens/Labour types (Dan Andrews, Andrew Barr, Andrew Leigh, Mark Dreyfuss, Penny Wong, Katy Gallagher, etc) are like this - women and blacks (tribal entitled victim narrative - on average) in particular rush to personal attack, "outrage" (18C) and victim narratives. Anything to stop debate. Muslims, Totalitarian/Authoritarian Chinese, Khans, Barbarians and extremely dim witted people do this - because they are deeply and permanently ignorant and are desperate to remain as ignorant as possible -"safe" from anxiety. Many people will say things like:

- Let us agree to disagree
- We have already had that debate
- The issue has been resolved
- There is nothing further to discuss
- I have mandated legislation on that in the constitution

Other people will deliberately re-evaluate previous decisions to see if it is time to change their position on a topic or move house or change jobs - active re-evaluation of circumstances and environment. Fat, Dumb and Lazy - people get stuck in Pig-ignorant complacency and failing to notice things around them.

Revisiting and checking things is an important part of human development. The idea of Maintenance for roads, houses, your health and the HEALTH OF THE NATION are important concepts. Things change all the time so instead of remaining Fat, Dumb and Lazy you need to double check and see if things are working - as intended and as expected.

This requires constant discussion and debate - which is a threat to sunk cost, confirmation bias internal schemas.

Imagine if you were in a spacecraft going through space. Every few minutes you would go through various check routines to make sure nothing was going wrong. You would remain alert and aware for things unexpected. Then you would rest and let someone else take over. Then after some rest you would start again looking, checking, discussing and making sure you were still on track. **You did not say** - this spacecraft is perfect, well designed (by gods) and therefore there is nothing left to do but go on our journey.

For example the United Nations is now mostly corrupt and Australian legislation like the Discrimination Act and Family Law have become fully corrupted by Women and Black tribes to the extent where most parts of society have been severely damaged. Education, Legal, Political and media organizations are all severely damaged and widespread tribalism, lies and corruption dominate much of public life. There were debates about science and maths from religious believers as well https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Orazio_Grassi Orazio Grassi (1583 to 1654) - a Jesuit (The Jesuits had established an Observatory in Rome - many Jesuits were trained and taught Maths and Astronomy) - debated in writing with https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Galileo_Galilei Galilei Galileo di Vincenzo Bonaiuti de' Galilei (1564 to 1642) about astronomy and the measurement of the path of comets in the sky but this was done as an argument of logic, facts and measurement - not an appeal to "God". Religious zealots learned maths so they could engage in the debate of their times - no matter what their personal beliefs.

Large numbers of humans are weak minded, tribal, uneducated and lack cognition ability and also lack opportunity to think and explore. Objective Truth does not matter to them - only tribal and mob subjective beliefs.

Most of the **religious type** arguments are based on assertions which go like this:

- All knowing all powerful imaginary creature claiming to be God talks to a human
- Human relates messages of God to others and becomes "messenger of God"
- Messenger of God becomes Authority figure with power over life and death
- Certainty is mandated in Books from the messenger of God and his followers
- Authoritarian and brutal regimes are established to keep the messenger of god, devotees, acolytes and their grifters powerful and wealthy

There had been revolts against the Dogma while still trying to maintain the simple beliefs of "Certain God" and doing "the good works". Many religious groups formed with the Pope's approval to spread the word of God more than the dogma. https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Philip Neri

Another method is to **avoid all debate** the **messenger of God** declares that He and his followers are the **extreme authority on any debate of any issue** - as the authorized messengers of "God" (of **certainly** everything) i.e. they declare that within themselves - as messengers of "God" that they have ultimate "Truth", ultimate "Reality" and ultimate Authority over Life and Death of everyone. - Wind, Storms, Seas, Volcanoes, Ghosts, Climate, Plagues, Famines, Societal breakdowns -"God's Wrath"
- Gods of some things like food, animals, trees, fertility, sea Local Gods
- Gods of Certainly Everything Many different all knowing Gods of Everything with different rules and dogma
- God of Aliens who know everything and are looking down from above on planet Earth from another planet or spaceship
- Gods of "Trust the Science"

The Constant Debates of Religious Believers

If you put all the religious believers into one room and asked them to explain how many people had been murdered throughout history for exactly what belief - they would not know. They would not know the detail of the arguments or the body counts of those killed. Who killed who for what reason. The word "Martyr" is used by some religious tribes when they describe the death of believers of THEIR OWN TRIBE and some of those killed have been magically declared "Saints" in "Heaven" - while others are consigned to "Hell" in binary certain ways. Tribal believers completely ignore the believers of OTHER TRIBES that their tribe has murdered. Women count women victims, Blacks count black victims, Jews count Jewish "martyrs", Catholics count Catholic "Martyrs" and muslims count Muslim "martyrs" - typically suicide bombers and murderers who die while killing people are called "martyrs" by muslims. This is different to Cathoilic, Protestent, Waldensian, Cathar Martyrs who were captured, arrested, tried and executed not for killing people or murdering people - only believing different things.


For example the Religious believers would not know how many people were tortured and joyously murdered for claiming that bread and wine were not magically turned into the body and blood of some mythical dead guy called Jesus Christ when priests chanted rituals, donned robes and bowed their heads. They would not know exactly how many Waldensians, Cathars, Quakers, Puritans, etc were tortured and murdered by whom and for what reason exactly. We do know some of the stories and we can see that the murderers had no doubts and were full of self belief. Many claimed themselves to be highly educated, intellectual and "Good". They use words to describe themselves like "On the Right Side of History" as we see now with many deluded politicians and murderous tyrants around the world. "The end ends justifies the means"

So can you imagine some kind of **new Game Show** where you put all the religious pious types in a room and **get them to explain** exactly why people should be killed for exactly what personal beliefs. Then if not death - torture, punishment, fines, imprisonment, etc. They could talk about history and death and all the reasons that people from their tribe of believers killed and tortured people from other tribes. Then you could have in the audience a group of "Experts" - expert historians, legal types, university professors - all who could comment on the debate. Mark Dreyfuss would be there explaining exactly why blacks are special tribes and women and men have to be split into tribal groupings. Religious "Historians" would simply deny the Jews were murdered by Hamas - that truth is not truth - in a kind of Orwellian post truth Way. Feminists experts would argue that killing men is OK but Woman and Their Children must always be "safe" - as legislated by Australian Parliament. Blacks experts would be there saying "You can Go now" to everyone and as "first nations" they

invented religion and religious murder. Pointing the bone and stranding people in the desert is "Not murder". Each expert could express their "beliefs".

Muslims don't count the people they murder and all nuance to religious debate is reduced to "unbelievers must believe what my tribe believes or they must be killed". Binary extremists, causists, religious fanatics, tribal types, tyrants, China, Russia, Women and Blacks (on average - tribal victim narratives) tend to this type of binary thinking as well - Us/Them.

That's why getting "believers" to write history is a problem - they tend to us the Focus Model to emphasize some things and completely ignore other things. They don't really want a comprehensive and cohesive view of anything - something closer to reality - instead they want to lie by omission or completely ignore things altogether. They are stuck in Belief and ignore reality.



The Search for Certain Belief - Oops, I have lost my Certainty

In the above document I explain how I gave myself **personal certainty** - a starting point for solid belief. In my case "I Will Never Rob a Bank" - and then **once this is believed with conviction** - without escape clauses or "perhaps" or "it depends on the circumstance" (Once zombies or aliens invade I will rob a bank) - this becomes a very real, describable, visualized and solid personal and private belief which helps ground things for you as you develop. More things are then able to be explored and questioned. You do not need to re-visit this kind of harmless belief - it is there for you alone - not on constant display of virtue or specialness (victim narratives) - it is for you alone, providing some self grounding. Some might describe this as some kind of **Moral position** and you can see what they mean. Other people might stake their internal belief on something like "I will kill as many people as I can" or "I will always lie to get what I want" or 'I will always do everything for Myself no matter what damage is caused to others". We can see this thinking in many people - narcissistic psychopaths and politicians seem to display this type of belief.

One of the many problems with religious types is belief is founded in delusion and vague notions "I Will Be Good" or "I Follow God's commandments as delivered by the local tyrannical psychopath of

today." Or "I will always do as I am told" or "I must obey the tribe", "Be kind to fairies at the bottom of the garden", "I must obey the Authoritarian Overlords" or some kind of list of documented "Commandments". Usually the "belief' has to be **displayed to the Tribe** so they do not kill you.

Maybe nations need some kind of contract law or business statement?



The Cartesian debates which raged in Utrecht and Leiden in the 1600s around Rene Descarte's philosophy were essentially about Doubt versus Certainty. They had very fiery debates about how certain they were about everything and much of that certainty manifested itself as mandated dogma, heresy and witch trials https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Benedikt Carpzov Jr. around the country and the rise of "Puritanism" and extreme mandated religious dogma. Algebra had become more complex



Professional "Expert" Theologians were threatened by Amateur thinkers making cogent Mathematical statements and correct Astronomical measurements and predictions.

Religious types kept asserting "God" and then "proving" their assertion https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Ramon_Llull - some with great long "logical" and "mathematical" statements - all failing to recognize the initial self-reference and recursions problems and their initial assumptions and assertions.

Spinoza was engaging with a tradition that held that God exists outside of the universe, that God created the universe for a reason, and that God could have created a different universe according to his will. Spinoza denies each point. According to Spinoza, God is the natural world. Spinoza concludes that God is the substance comprising the universe; that God exists in itself, not outside of the universe; and that the universe exists as it does from necessity, not because of a divine theological reason or will.... Spinoza then uses the Ontological Argument as justification for the existence of God and argues that God must possess all attributes infinitely. Since no two things can share attributes, "besides God no substance can be granted or conceived."

"God is Nature, Nature is god" Initial self reference and Recursion. a priori. Once again Infinity becomes the definition i.e. infinitely undefined infinitely unmeasured as per my Plurality Model



Other asserted that Orthodoxy (**traditional beliefs** - e.g. "God" "That's the way we do things around here") were the essential starting point because nothing is perfect so we have to start somewhere it may as well be Traditional "God" https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Gisbertus Voetius "He maintained that human beings would be able to learn the truth from divine revelation, which was the only principle in the pursuit of truth." i.e. you cannot have" truth" without belief in "god".

Debates about **maths and science** became (and still is) a major focus of thinkers and workers from around the time of Descartes - books, universities, scholars, and many others could DEBATE the topics of maths and science - blood, bones, medicine, botany, zoology, geology, history, anatomy,

optics, astronomy, chemistry, metallurgy, etc - WITHOUT KILLING PEOPLE FOR THEIR PERSONAL BELIEFS.

Journals and Magazines published scientific debates and arguments so more people could be involved in the exploration of ideas.

Vigorous, critical, public debate was encouraged. Not only at universities and between universities - but by letters, books and journals - a culture of debate was encouraged. Now in Australia there is no debate about anything. **Experts mandate the dogma**. Scientific journals are "**Peer-reviewed**" (by friends and paid reviewers) rather that critically and thoroughly examined. E.g. While universities were growing in Europe in the 1600s - universities in Australia are stagnating and becoming more tribal with Tribal activists stopping debates and cancelling classes. The Bounds of Freedom and Choice

https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Francis Turretin "The inability to do good is strongly asserted, but the essence of freedom is not destroyed" (Institutio theologiae elencticae, 10.2.9). They still have liberty which is not repugnant to certain kinds of necessity. For Turretin, neither the entities of the will nor the intellect are either the sole faculty of free will, which is rather conceived of **their plurality** as a mixed faculty. "As it belongs to the intellect with regard to the decision of choice, so it belongs to the will with regard to freedom" (Institutio theologiae elencticae, 10.1.4). Turretin distinguishes six kinds of necessity (Institutio, 10.2.4–9): physical necessity, necessity of coercion, necessity of dependence on God, rational necessity, moral necessity, and necessity of event. The first two among these six necessities are incompatible with freedom, whereas the latter four are not only compatible with freedom but perfect it. For example, treating upon the compatibility of moral necessity, Turretin asserts, despite the fact that a will can be rendered "slavish" if determined by habit to a manner of action, that "this servitude by no means overthrows the true and essential nature of liberty" (Institutio theologiae elencticae, 10.2.8). For Turretin, freedom does not arise from an indifference of the will. No rational beings are indifferent to good and evil. The will of an individual human being is never indifferent in the sense of possessing an equilibrium, either before or after the fall. Turretin defines freedom with the notion of rational spontaneity (Institutio, 10.2.10-11)"

We are not "Free" to flap our arms and fly into heaven. "Freedoms" exists with a frame of some kind - the State, the Place we are, the Time, the bounds and constraints applicable at the time and place we are.

The Choice to do nothing exists then followed by infinitely many possible some things - even some things not yet thought of.

The churches are many and fair; in one of them lies buried the learned and illustrious **Joseph Scaliger**, without any extraordinary inscription, who, having left the world a monument of his worth more lasting than marble, needed nothing more than his own name; which I think is all engraven on his sepulcher. 28th August, 1641. I went to see the college and schools, which are nothing extraordinary, and was complimented with a matricula by the magnificus Professor, who first in Latin demanded of me where my lodging in the town was, my name, age, birth, and to what Faculty I addicted myself; then, recording my answers in a book, he administered an oath to me that I should observe the statutes and orders of the University while I stayed, and then delivered me a ticket, by virtue whereof I was made excise-free; for all which worthy privileges, and the pains of writing, he accepted of a rix-dollar.

There is without the town a fair Mall, curiously planted.

Returning to my lodging, I was showed the statue, cut in stone, of the happy monk, whom they report to have been the **first inventor of typography**, set over the door; but this is much controverted by others, who strive for the glory of it, besides John Gutenberg.
