First olgia (Panderers and Seducers)

**Panderers and seducers** are punished here. They are forced to march, single file around the circumference of their circle, constantly lashed by horned demons.

Second Bolgia (Flatterers)

Sinners guilty of **excessive flattery** are punished in this bolgia, immersed forever in a river of human excrement, similar to what their flatteries were. Thais the hetaira is found there.

Third Bolgia (Simoniacs) <a href="https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Simony">https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Simony</a> trafficking for money in "spiritual things"

Simoniacs are punished here. They are turned upside down in large baptismal fonts cut into the rock, with their feet set ablaze by oily fires. The heat of the flames burns according to the guilt of the sinner. Popes condemned to Bolgia Three all go into the same font, the earlier ones pushed down by the later arrivals. Pope Nicholas III is found here, and informs Dante that Pope Boniface VIII will follow.

Fourth Bolgia (Sorcerers)

Sorcerers, astrologers, seers, and others who attempted to pervert God's laws to divine the future are punished here. Their heads have been twisted around to face backwards, and thus they are forced to walk backwards around the circumference of their circle for all eternity. They also are blinded by their tears; therefore they cannot walk in straight paths. The seers Tiresias and his daughter, Manto, reside in this bolgia.

### Fifth Bolgia (Barrators)

Barrators (speculators, extortionists, blackmailers and unscrupulous businessmen: sinners who used their positions in life to gain personal wealth or other advantages for themselves) are punished by being thrown into a river of boiling pitch and tar. In addition, should any of the grafters try to escape the pitch, a horde of demons known as Malebranche, armed with grappling hooks and barbs, stand guard over them, ready to tear them to pieces.

# Sixth Bolgia (Hypocrites)

Hypocrites are punished in this bolgia. They are forced to wear heavy lead robes as they walk around the circumference of their circle. The robes are golden and resemble a monk's cowl but are lined with heavy lead, symbolically representing hypocrisy. Also, Caiaphas, the Pharisee who insisted on the execution of Jesus, and all of the Sanhedrin are crucified in this circle, staked to the ground so that the ranks of the lead-weighted hypocrites march across him.

## Seventh Bolgia (Thieves)

This bolgia houses the souls of fraudulent thieves.[3] In Inferno 24, the thieves are trapped in a self-perpetuating cycle of being bitten and bound by serpents, dragons and other vengeful reptiles.[4] Thieves are bitten by snakes, turning their bodies into ash before spontaneously regenerating their bodies again for further torment.[4] Others are bitten by snakes and are transformed into snakes that, in turn, minister the punishment onto other souls.[4] Here, the souls turn against each other, reflecting how theft breaks the intrinsic bonds of trust and community that holds society together.[5] In Inferno 25, the pilgrim witnesses a group of Florentine nobles violently latch onto each other, transmuting their bodies into a monstrous hybrid.[4] These transformations reference tales from the Metamorphoses of Ovid, such Salmacis and her fusion with Hermaphroditus.[3][4] Just as the thieves robbed others of their property, this punishment robs the fraudulent thieves of their most inalienable properties: their bodies and identity.[3][5]

In this bolgia, the pilgrim also meets Vanni Fucci, a thief who lived in Pistoia.[4] Vanni Fucci delivers a prophecy about Dante's fate in Florence before throwing an obscene gesture towards God and is punished by the centaur Cacus.[4]

### Eighth Bolgia (Counselors of Fraud)

The eighth bolgia is dedicated to the counselors of fraud—individuals who **provided fraudulent advice or used fraud to bring about the downfall of others**.[4][6] Here, the souls are burned in brilliant flames.[4][6]

In Inferno 26, the pilgrim meets Ulysses and Diomedes, in the form of twin flames, who are placed in this bolgia for using the Trojan Horse as a trap to besiege Troy and for deceiving Achilles to war.[4]

Ulysses tells an altered version of his last voyage: instead of returning to Ithaca, Ulysses and his crew shipwrecked in front of Mount Purgatory in a quest for knowledge.[4][7] Ulysses' last voyage draws many parallels to the pilgrim's journey in the Divine Comedy. Both embark on a journey for the pursuit of greater understanding.[7] In Ulysses' case, his pursuit for knowledge was misguided, which ultimately led to his spiritual shipwreck.[7] Unlike Ulysses, the pilgrim's journey is ordained by divine powers.[4] Thus, the pilgrim's journey into the self will not end in disaster.[6][4]

In Inferno 27, the pilgrim encounters Guido da Montefeltro, who was placed in this bolgia for providing fraudulent advice that lead in exchange for a promise of salvation from Pope Boniface VIII.[4] He first asks the pilgrim about the current state of affairs in Florence before narrating what led to his downfall and eventual placement in Hell.[4]

### Ninth Bolgia (Sowers of Discord)

Sinners who, in life, **promoted scandals, schism, and discord** are punished here; particularly those who caused schism within the church or within politics. They are forced to walk around the circumference of the circle bearing horrible, disfiguring wounds inflicted on them by a great demon with a sword. The nature of the wound mirrors the sins of the particular soul; while some only have gashes, or fingers and toes cut off, others are decapitated, cut in half (as schismatics), or are completely disemboweled. Among those who are tormented here is Muhammad, prophet of Islam and his son-in-law and successor Ali, who both eviscerate their own bodies, and Bertran de Born, alleged agitator of the Revolt of 1173–74, who carries around his severed head like a lantern.

Tenth Bolgia (Falsifiers)

Gustave Doré - Dante and Virgil overlooking the tenth bolgia, Canto XXIX)

Falsifiers, those who attempted to alter things through lies or alchemy, or those who tried to pass off false things as real things, such as counterfeiters of coins, are punished here. This bolgia has four subdivisions where specific classes of falsifiers (alchemists, impostors, counterfeiters, and liars) endure different degrees of punishment based on horrible, consumptive diseases such as rashes, dropsy, leprosy and consumption (known today as tuberculosis). Among them is Myrrha, who suffers from insanity after she seduced her father.

The lower edge of Malebolge is guarded by a ring of titans and earth giants, many of whom are chained in place as punishment for their rebellion against God. Beyond and below the giants lies Cocytus, Hell's final depth.

Many of these categories of people dominate society now especially in the west. Notably the science industry is completely dominated by "Falsifiers, Sorcerers and Barrators" who either lie outright or use the Emphasis and Omission binary switch routine to hide the full picture - the truth - for their own profit and rewards. # Introduction

Some of the greatest people in human history were born during the 1600's. This was a period when thoughts about people and society were developing rapidly. It was period of great debates and explorations of ideas. The idea of nations was growing, economies were growing, people were exploring and discovering things which were all leading to better standards of living for all and more sustainable economies. Huge libraries of Greek, Roman, Hebrew and other human creations were being built storied, copied and shared. People looked backwards into the ancient world and the recent past for current ideas - then they looked forward to new ideas with laws, politics, education, nations, finance, trade and the social contract. Intellectual debate was fierce - but was in stark contrast to the religious wars, heresy and witch trials which were gradually reducing from mainstream focus to become fringe issues of less developed groups.

France had the Salon culture and were starting to develop a kind of French smug arrogance which can develop of hundreds of years to become the "norm" or expected standard. Voltaire was about to establish himself standing up against Catholic religious tyranny in France.

There were still various wars between the countries and some allegiances changed - the English, Dutch and French were engaged with many wars - the Spanish War of succession was about to emerge, Polish Lithuanian Commonwealth and Sweden and Russia were engaged in revolutions and wars. There were witch trials in some places - USA, Scotland and local heresy trials but it seemed like everything on the human world was operating on a much grander scale - every place was becoming more connected and ideas were being shared widely which I suspect had a moderating influence - like a dampening effect of some of the extremists.

It is only when you can look backwards and forwards in time to see the events and influences and the actions of those who came after that you can get some greater understanding of what was significant. This is not only "Synthesis" and pulling many threads together. The sequence of things things which seemed to make an impact. Some of the biggest widespread impacts were

- Widespread public discourse
- Reading and Writing
- Examining History
- Debating things in detailed writing
- Exploring and Hypothesizing new ideas which could be tested

You may think that I am simply stating the obvious - but some times these obvious things and things we take for granted are the most important things we need to ensure we do not lose sight of.

Socrates was seen a new in the 1600's and the Greeks and Romans in general were widely explored and routinely taught in Schools - an understanding of them and their time was growing. **Galileo Galilei had defied the Religious Zealots - not as a martyr for his beliefs - but for his demonstrably** 

**true facts about the Earth.** His stance and the reality he presented was a **significant shift for Humankind** - suddenly reality and Truth existed outside of dogmatic belief. This was significant development in human History - every bit as significant as the need to Question things which Socrates had died for.

**Socrates** and **Galileo** inspired humans from then on. The idea of exploring debates and ideas from many sides we get from Socrates - escape from tyrannical certainty and celebrating the idea of the "Question" and debates.

**Galileo** inspired the ideas of science, truth and argument - even while under extreme pressure from believers - no longer were humans to be always dominated by Religious Zealots - These are ideas of the west that still struggle to permeate the Muslim and other binary religious minds.

# The Need for a Perpetrator

You can image a 6 year child twerking and putting on a display like some kind of Trans Activist Library reader (funded by Dan Andrews) thinking that that's the way people are supposed to behave. Is the child to blame? or the victim of pig-ignorant tribal adults, teachers and politicians?

But even up to the aged of 30 - people are still trying to work out how to have a relationship and what sex is. Must there always be a Victim? Why?

Are victims always groups? Why do victims have to be categorized as group?

"A Ferry sunk drowning the passengers and killing all on board - Women and their Children, Dogs, a Koala in a cage being transported to a Zoo (Mourned by Tanya Plibersek) and others."

"Women are the biggest victims of War" - Hillary Clinton, Malcolm Turnbull.

What about two people who get drunk and go to a place together in private and they both agree. What right then does anyone have to invade their home or castle and tell them how to behave? And surely adults **can learn over time** to sort things out for themselves than call the police, lawyers, courts and media to claim their "Victimhood"?

The thing is - if there is no victim - THEN YOU DO NOT NEED TO DESIGNATE A PERPETRATOR. (Drama Triangle - binaries, groupthink more than 70% of the population are binary thinkers - groupthink, etc)

This is not - "They are both as Bad as each other" - instead it is:

**THERE WAS NO VICTIM** - The human condition. **Imagine that** - a world where there was not a constant scramble to publicly claim victim status!

Binaries don't get this idea. They lack cognition and feel good instead about being a victim or hero.

#### They are driven by their feelings - they smile and "Feel Good"

Anthony Albanese says "I am Good, I am on the Right Side of History" - what a delusional dimwit he is. Very much like black women politicians in USA.

Many childcare centers, kindergartens and schools claim Girls are victims of Boys - this is part of the **Entitled Victim Narrative** which Women, Blacks (On Average) and weak minded men and habitually follow. Binary extremists, religious Zealots, Causists and other binary tribal types tend to **always intentionally adopt the victim stance** in the Drama Triangle. Many good young men are hounded out of working with children because of aggressive and abusive women playing victim and alleging perpetrators everywhere.

This kind of MOBTHINK and GROUP TRIBAL warfare dominates the history of humans - along with the Barbarian wars which is largely non tribal and dominate by narcissistic psychopathic individual violence of the Huns, Khans and other Barbarian types.

For Example **Peta Credlin is proudly strong** on Women's causes - She believes having an Office of Women and "Keeping Women and their Children Safe" is a really important message that needs to be government funded and a "Respect" campaign for women (women must be respected) is a good idea and everyone needs to do more for women. None of these things outrage her nor the family court treatment of men or male suicides. What outrages her is how her women friends may be treated by members of the Liberal Party. Not only the Liberal party (her political group) but everyone needs to do much more for women and women's causes and there is much more to be done for women - the job and cause of helping women is not over yet and has a "long way to go - don't we

girls". She is proud of helping women in the same way the ABC and the Guardian and media in general are proud of helping women - giving publicity to women and encouraging women who are proud and courageous enough to call out a "Kill all Men" narrative on behalf of all women. It is important to have a discrimination Act which supports constant discrimination in favour of women and blacks and supports and encourages discrimination against men. The Idea that someone in politics and media can debate the big ideas in society and completely ignore tribalness and tribal identity is simply beyond women and blacks (on average - entitled tribal victim narratives), Binary Extremists, Marxists, Religious Fanatics, Muslims and weak minded men playing hero in the drama triangle. Margaret Thatcher was a prime minister of Britain worthy of that title.

Binaries lack cognition or any real understanding of anything much in the world - they tend to tribalism, drama triangle and violence.

Now the "Social Contract" <a href="https://iep.utm.edu/soc-cont/">https://iep.utm.edu/soc-cont/</a> is to have more targets for women. 60% women in the public service is not enough and we have yet to achieve <a href="equality">equality</a> "We still have a long way to go" says Peta. We need to do more for groupthink and victim tribe groups say the binaries.

The same tribalism and virtue signaling as Joe Biden who announced he had appointed a Black Women judge to the Supreme court. The same way the Nobel peace prize committee gave an award to Barack Obama because he was black. What person with any dignity accepts an award for being Black? 



The **New Science** was a book by **Giambattista Vico** covering a wide range of human history, philosophy and thought as well as observations and concepts about the nature of humankind on a very broad scale. It represents a major attempt to pull many ideas together in a cohesive way and talk about complex issues affecting humanity. There was an appetite for this type of deep thinking and analysis at his time although it took hundreds of years for many to see the depth and character of his major exploration. Thomas Hobbes and others had attempted to explore and explain humanity, nations, commonwealths, Laws, Royalty, etc. and how things fitted together - **Giambattista Vico** continued that exploration.

Science was a growing exploration into things rather the dogma of Papal Bulls and edicts issued by a Pope. So to talk about humans and the way they lived in Nations at his time in history was a significant change to a world dominated by religion and religious (and their tyrants) authority of the affairs of men.

He lived in southern Italy - which was different to papal and religious Italy and even the Holy Roman Empire in Europe - I have not worked it out yet by I think Frederick II was a big influence on Sicily, Naples and southern Italy <a href="https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Frederick II">https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Frederick II</a>, Holy Roman Emperor it seemed to me to be a melting pot of the Etrustcan tribes, Visogoths, Greek cities, Jewish enclaves, under constant attack from Muslims and Berbers - the historical Greeks in Sicily and the active Volcanoes in their area as constant almost daily reminder of the chaos of life. I can see how this area


is still a bit fiercely proudly protective and tribal. Naples and Sicily were different to Rome and had experienced different things which shaped its development.

His work comes after the work and influence of many other before him - not only from the history and Greeks and Romans but also the ongoing debates about NATIONS and how Nations might exist as separate entities. He was aware of the North American Colonies and their attempts at constitutions. It is worth a read but the aspects of the "Peotic" and the balancing of things to avoid tyranny stand out for me. Balancing the needs of the individuals with group (Nation) concepts is modeled by me using my **Plurality model** and his statement of God being Infinite is recognized on the plurality model as the "God point" of infinite null and infinite measurement. His "Just Difference" I see as a non-binary continuum which pushes towards the Nation as a group to form the plurality curve - Just Difference is **not to serve** the "Equality" - because "Equality, Diversity and Inclusion" have **become the latest binary tyranny** but to serve a kind a "Plurality" which is **sufficiently certain** and **sufficiently vague** to overcome Draconian legal grifters and Authoritarian psychopaths who dominate much of humankind at the moment.

That God is "infinite power knowledge and will" (posse nosse velle infinitum) and man "finite power knowledge and will struggling towards the infinite" (posse nosse velle finitum quod tendit ad infinitum): that the state is the image of God, and because "it has all things beneath it, nothing above" (omnia infra se, nil superius habet), therefore "it renders account to God alone and to no one else" (uni Deo, praeterea reddat rationem nemini), and that just as in God freedom is inherent in his eternal reason, so the state freely obeys the laws it has itself established: that justice "directs and equates utilities" (utilitates dirigit et exaequat), directing, like an architect, in the building-up of the state, the two particular kinds of justice, commutative and distributive, the two divine artisans that measure utility with the two divine measures, arithmetic and geometry, so that "what is equal when you measure is also just when you choose" (quod est aequum cum metiris, idem est iustum quum eligis),[Pg 96] these and similar assertions seem not merely lacking in originality but even false or meaningless, adorned though they may be with the name either of **Aristotle** or of **Campanella** or of other philosophers of the ancient world or the Renaissance. If, to take one, justice consisted in measuring, a philosophy of justice would be unnecessary, for the science of calculation and measurement would be enough. Vico himself at one point involuntarily and ingenuously discloses the vicious circle of this metaphor substituted for a concept, by saying that men ought "to share utility equally among themselves, only preserving a just difference where it is a question of desert, and that to preserve the **equality**."



So to highlight this point (I think I may be one of few people to notice this point in history) - what had started as a discussion about a-priori - what has come before where did everything start? <a href="https://plato.stanford.edu/entries/apriori/">https://plato.stanford.edu/entries/apriori/</a> and comes mainly from Aristotle and <a href="https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Prior\_Analytics">https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Prior\_Analytics</a> Prior Analytics - which been established as a main thought exploration - we have infinitesimals being discovered in maths by Newton, Leibniz and others and being accepted as topic of exploration. This shifts the focus from - what came before (in a sequence) to what is infinity? How can I understand Infinity? How did eternity arise? - Which is still a kind of a-priori but it now focuses on a specific thing - eternity and infinitesimals - which is being explored more with logic and maths as well as philosophy. So the emphasis changes from a deterministic, fatalistic dogmatically determined sequential universe into a study of the meaning of infinity and "Eternal" an infinity of possibilities - what a huge mental shift.

#### 1. What is noticed as a thing?



What is that? Says the creature when a new molecule or event is noticed. The creature has a reaction to the thing. This reaction I call the **What**. The creature can reject or accept the thing. It becomes a declared thing. It **is declared**. <a href="https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Eukaryote">https://en.wikipedia.org/wiki/Eukaryote</a> 2200 million years ago. The noticed thing which invokes a What response becomes over time a Declared Thing. Is declared.

You can also compare that to cosmic events like the formation of solar systems or the meteor that crashes into Earth and becomes part of the Earth or the energy from the sun which enters the Earth. When is a Thing a Thing?

## 2. The infinite Not of the thing declared

The **infinite Not** is **often overlooked** but is a fundamental philosophical principle which helps include infinity in the discussion and overcomes infinite recursions. If some thing is the "Declared is" then we automatically have an infinity of things which are not the thing declared - the declared is. This is the bottom line on my plurality model. So the thing declared - the declared is - resides in a infinity of Nots. What is the **Opposite** of an Apple ? An infinity of things which are Not the Apple. In other words **Opposite** is NOT and not the same as **Comparison** as in - let us compare two things (or more) to see how they overlap. The **confusion is** that humans use the word "**Opposite**" when they really mean "**Compared to**". Or to put it another way - The Apple is compared to infinitely every possible thing real and imagined. So **Comparison** is a **SPECIFIC CASE** of **Opposite**. The Noticed thing - the declared is - seems very much like an apple - sufficiently enough (in a pluralistic sense) for me to declare it as an apple. We need to know where our infinites are.



#### 3. Comparing two things - Same Different


The next great step is differentiation - is it the same declared thing or a different thing. The ability to detect differences improves and we develop special techniques to allow differentiation of things. By comparing two things we can declare (as group terms) whether they are the Same or Different in a binary way. This **Grouping technique** and binary classification technique is a very strong and deep capability in Humans and done automatically in many ways. It allows us to build conceptual hierarchies. We do it rapidly, automatically and without noticing we are doing it - we are unaware of our deeply entrenched habits.

The top left box becomes the combination of the two things declared and binary thinkers (I estimate at more than 70% of the human population) mostly get stuck here - they miss the continuum and the things declared (they focus instead on the binary certain overlap - this Binary extremism is called in Universities around the world as "Intersectional theory"

), the infinite nots and they also miss the bottom right side box of the two infinite nots - The Double Not. This double not also conceptually similar to the Neti, Neti of the ancients and is considered to represent a very high level of understanding. The inference being that people who can grasp this concept of the double negative recursive infinities seem to be able to develop greater understanding about things around them. They are not stuck in

their Known Certainties - Confirmation Bias (Binary certainty) and Sunk Cost Bias (Fat, Dumb and Lazy)

This binary certain view appears as intersectional theory, multiculturalism, tribalism, Feminism, Black Activism, Religion, Marxism, Class Warfare, Communism, Equality, Diversity, Inclusion, Entitled Victim Narratives and tribal warfare.

Fisher observed how difficult it was to explain n the Null Hypothesis test to university students. To highlight this point - a very small number -say less than 1% of university professors have any idea about what I have just attempted to explain - they have no cognitive appreciation of the concepts, the meaning or importance of this. They do not have any understanding of this. So if you understand this then you have to appreciate that you have a cognitive ability - at least in this regard - which is very rare and extremely difficult to explain to binary thinkers and even highly educated people who think they can think. As a read the writings of others I am always checking to see if they are stuck in binary habitual thinking. If you can understand any of this I call this level 3 thinking (non-Binary).

#### 5. Sufficient Reason

How, where, why things happen or exist is explored by trying to establish reasons.


# 6. Sequence and Logic


Most humans adopt 4 main habitual differentiation responses - Same/Different, Good/Bad, Group/Individual and Us/Them (tribalism)

The second is of those who put passion in the place of reason, and being resolved that shall govern their actions and arguments, neither use their own, nor hearken to other people's reason, any further than it suits their humor, interest, or party; and these one may observe commonly content themselves with words which have no distinct ideas to them, though in other matters, that they come with an unbiased indifferency to, they want not abilities to talk and hear reason, where they have no secret inclination that hinders them from being tractable to it.
- 3. The third sort is of those who readily and sincerely follow reason, but for want of having that which one may call large, sound, roundabout sense, have not a full view of all that relates to the question, and may be of moment to decide it. We are all shortsighted, and very often see but one side of a matter; our views are not extended to all that has a connection with it. From this defect I think no man is free. We see but in part, [10] and we know but in part, and therefore it is no wonder we conclude not right from our partial views. This might instruct the proudest esteemer of his own parts, how useful it is to talk and consult with others, even such as come short of him in capacity, quickness, and penetration; for since no one sees all, and we generally have different prospects of the same thing according to our different, as I may say, positions to it, it is not incongruous to think, nor beneath any man to try, whether another may not have notions of things which have escaped him, and which his reason would make use of if they came into his mind. The faculty of reasoning seldom or never deceives those who trust to it; its consequences, from what it builds on, are evident and certain; but that which it oftenest, if not only, misleads us in is, that the principles from which we conclude the grounds upon which we bottom our reasoning, are but a part; something is left out, which should go into the reckoning, to make it just and exact. Here we may imagine a vast and almost infinite advantage that angels and separate spirits[11] may have over us, who in their several degrees of elevation above us may be endowed with more comprehensive faculties; and some of them perhaps, having perfect and exact views of all finite beings that come under their consideration, can, as it were, in the twinkling of an eye, collect together all their scattered and almost boundless relations. A mind so furnished, what reason has it to acquiesce in the certainty of its conclusions!

Thus have they spirited people up to this unnecessary and burthensome piece of generosity unknown to our forefathers, who only gave gifts to servants at Christmas-tide, which custom is yet kept into the bargain; insomuch that a maid shall have eight pounds per annum in a gentleman's or merchant's family. And if her master is a man of free spirit, who receives much company, she very often doubles her wages by her veils; thus having meat, drink, washing, and lodging for her labour, she throws her whole income upon her back, and by this means looks more like the mistress of the family than the servant-wench.
